As a follow-up to our recent telephone conversation, this will confirm the foreclosure involving Tropical Mobile Home Park is still in progress. A review of the wastewater treatment plant on site reveals it is not in operation nor do we believe it is functional at this time. We have had an engineer review the system and he is currently in the process of setting up a conference to meet with local representatives of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

Preliminarily, it appears that a new wastewater treatment system would have to be installed in order to bring this system into compliance with existing regulations. In all likelihood if this were to occur, the owner would seek an exemption from the jurisdiction of the Public Service Commission. My client is currently considering all of its options in terms of the required steps to bring the mobile home park back into compliance with all existing regulatory requirements.
