current certificates, so they can be updated with the final order. ACK 3. As required by Rule 25-30.037(3)(e), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) provide a AFA statement describing the financing of the purchase. The utility statement that the purchase of stock APP of Lake Holding, Inc. is a cash transaction financed by a loan from First Union is not sufficient. CAF Please provide the amount financed and the terms of the loan. CMU Based on your response in the application to item number 10, is it correct that all CTR _ regulatory assessment fees for 1998 will be paid by Utilities, Inc. or will the fees be prorated EAG between the buyer and seller? Please clarify. LEG 5. Based on your response in the application to item number 10, is it correct that you will LIN satisfy all refund obligations from the over collection of CIAC gross-up in the pending docket OPC 981070-WS or will the original owners remain responsible?
