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

## **PERIOD FOR ACTIVITIES:**

October, November, and December 1998

#### **PROGRAM STATUS:**

The FPL Green Pricing Research and Development Project (GPRDP) was approved by the Commission in Order No. PSC-97-FOF-0528-EG, dated May 7, 1997. This program is designed to allow FPL the flexibility to test FPL customer response to a Green Pricing Initiative. Under the GPRDP, FPL will solicit contributions from its customers to be used to purchase, install, maintain, and operate Photovoltaic (PV) modules on FPL's system.

FPL has completed the education and solicitation campaign for the project and has proceeded with the design and implementation phases.

### **ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED:**

- 1. FPL completed the development of the design specifications for the actual photovoltaic facility and maximized the generation output for the level of funding received.
- 2. FPL developed a preliminary list of qualified providers of photovoltaic equipment installations.
- 3. FPL drafted a "Request For Proposal" (RFP), with the Florida Solar Energy Center's assistance, to be sent to potential providers of PV equipment.
