

Dear Chairman Garcia:

Lake Utility Services, Inc. (LUSI) hereby makes the following offer to settle the above referenced case which, if accepted by the Commission, would dispose of this case without the necessity of further proceedings. It is believed that this settlement is acceptable to the Commission Staff.

- LUSI agrees to refund AFPI charges to Ms. Kathy Shutts and to Ms. Sandy Baron in the amount of \$608.09 each, within 30 days after the issuance of the Commission's order approving this offer of settlement.
- In addition, LUSI further agrees to credit the Contributions-in-Aid-of-Construction account in the amount of \$25,800 to reflect past period adjustments to AFPI revenues previously collected.
