<u>Issue 3</u>: Should the Commission fine Patricia Deihl \$10,000 for apparent violation of Rule 25-4.043, Florida Administrative Code, Response to Commission Staff Inquiries?

<u>Recommendation</u>: The Commission should impose a \$10,000 fine for failure to comply with Rule 25-4.043, Florida Administrative Code. The fine should be remitted within 5 business days after the conclusion of the 21-day protest period. The fine should be paid to the Florida Public Service Commission and forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the Commission's order is not protested and the fine is not received, it should be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for collection.
