include protection of public health and the environment. The Commission action in this docket will substantially influence how electric power is provided to Floridians, what energy resources are relied on, and how much utilities should rely on demand side energy services.

5. Issues of fact include whether the methodologies used to evaluate peninsular Florida reserve margins adequately consider the effects of demand-side management alternatives. LEAF reserves the right to raise additional issues as they become known.

6. This docket will determine the bases on which decisions regarding power plant need and the use of demand resourceswill be made. The following statutes and rules entitle LEAF to relief: rules 28-106 and 25-22 FAC; Chapters 120 and 366, Florida Statutes. LEAF reserves the right to rely on additional legal authority.

WHEREFORE, LEAF respectfully requests to be allowed to intervene as a party to this proceeding.
