TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY'S POST-HEARING STATEMENT OF ISSUES AND POSITIONS

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "the company"), pursuant to the Prehearing Order issued in this docket on February 8, 1999, submits the following as its Post-Hearing Statement of Issues and Positions:

Basic Position

Transmission revenues should be allocated according to transmission usage. A transmission related separation factor based on coincident peak demand properly allocates transmission revenues between the retail and wholesale jurisdictions.
