1 PROCEEDINGS 2 WHEREUPON, 3 FRANCES CHANDLER, 4 having been first duly sworn, was examined and testified 5 as follows: 6 DIRECT EXAMINATION 7 BY MR. GROOT: Okay. Would you please state your full name 8 Q 9 again. 10 Frances Chandler. 11 Okay. Are you the same Frances Ellen Q 12 Chandler that testified in this proceeding on December 13 22nd of last year? 14 Α Yes, I am. Have your qualifications changed in any way 15 since that testimony that you gave? 16 No, they haven't. 17 A Are you still in the same position that you 18 were in at that point in time? 19 Yes, I am. 20 Α You continue to be Planning Development 21 22 Director since that time? 23 Α Yes, I have. 24 Now, since your testimony on December 22nd,

1998 have there been any changes that you believe should

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be brought to the attention of the Florida Public
Service Commission and any others involved in this
proceeding relative to the east area of Seminole County,
the Comprehensive Plan of Seminole County as it applies
to the eastbound area and the proposed expansion of the
water and sewer service by the Florida Water Service?

A Yes, there are.

Q What are those matters that you believe should be brought forward at this time?

A On January 27th, 1999 the Seminole County
Board of County Commissioners held a public hearing to
review the land uses and urban service boundary for the
area including the area surrounding Chuluota. At time
they transmitted a small area study as well as
amendments to the comprehensive plan to the Department
of Community Affairs for their review which amended the
urban boundary in this area.

Q When you say "transmitted", does that indicate a final action of any type?

A No.

Q Okay. What final action would occur relative to those matters which you have just testified were transmitted to the Florida Department of Community Affairs?

A It would be a second public hearing by the

Board of County Commissioners that would adopt any final 1 amendment associated with that transmittal. 2 Have you discussed the eastbound area study 3 Q and the extension of the urban boundary with the staff 4 of the Florida Department of Community Affairs? 5 Α Yes, I have. 6 Do you have any indication that that 7 department would object to that which the county has 8 9 done? I have no indication at this time. 10 Okay. Assuming that no changes are made as 11 Q to the planned amendments transmitted by the Board of 12 County Commissioners and, in fact, they are adopted in 13 the future would that then be a final action absent any 14 15 challenge or appeal? Yes, it would. 16 Α And the urban boundaries would have been 17 expanded by that action? 18 19 Α Yes, it would. In your professional opinion what would that 20 have meant with regard to the interrelationship of the 21 22 Seminole County Comprehensive plan proposed by FWS?

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provided for additional lands that would be available to have central services and still be consistent with the policies of the comprehensive plan.

Q Okay. Now, the -- would the application for expansion that has been filed with the PFC by FWS still go beyond that which the Board of County Commissioners has indicated that it will expound the urban boundary to?

A Yes, it would.

Q And what would your professional opinion be as to those out of the boundary?

A The policies of the comprehensive plan have not been proposed to be amended that I testified about before such that that any extension of central service outside the urban boundary are still prohibited under the comprehensive plan.

Q Has there been any discussion relative to any possible expansion of water -- excuse me, potable water service areas, a potable water service area beyond the urban boundary?

A By?

Q Okay, scratch that. I'll reask the question.

Has there been any discussion by any county staff or

board relative to the possibility of having the Seminole

County Comprehensive Plan adjusted such that potable

water service could be permitted beyond the urban 1 boundary into rural densities? 2 The local planning agency at the public 3 hearing regarding the small area study for Chuluota as 4 well as these planned amendments did discuss and 5 recommend to the Board of County Commissioners policies 6 that would have allowed for that extension to occur. 7 The Board, however, did not transmit those. 8 9 Is there any action being taken at this time Q 10 at the staff level relative to those proposals? 11 Α Not at this time. 12 Are there any exhibits or documents or plans 0 13 that you believe would be helpful in terms of 14 understanding the testimony you've just given? 15 Α 16 17 18

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The Seminole County Chuluota small area study has been prepared in four volumes in executive summary. A final report, Volume One, a final report, Volume two and Appendix A to the final report all of which would be important to this discussion.
