## STATEMENT OF CHANGES

Rule 25-6.093(3)(d) was changed to 1) give the affected utilities the option of providing the fuel source of generation information by either bill insert <u>or</u> as a message on the customer bill; and 2) to permit the sources of generation information to be submitted for the most recent 12-month period <u>available</u>. The first change provides greater flexibility. The second change allows for the time required to obtain final data and to prepare and print the bill inserts. 25-6.093 Information to Customers.

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(1) Each utility shall, upon request of any customer, give
such information and assistance as is reasonable, in order that
the customer may secure safe and efficient service. Upon
request, the utility shall provide any customer information as to
the method of reading meters and the derivation of billing
therefrom, the billing cycle and approximate date of monthly
meter reading.

9 (2) Upon request of any customer, the utility is required
10 to provide to the customer a copy and/or explanation of the
11 utility's rates and provisions applicable to the type or types of
12 service furnished or to be furnished such customer, and to assist
13 the customer in obtaining the rate schedule which is most
14 advantageous to the customer's requirements.

(3) (a) By bill insert or other appropriate means of communication, the utility shall give to each of its customers a summary of major rate schedules which are available to the class of which that customer is a member, and

(b) the utility shall provide the information contained in paragraph (a) to all its customers:

Not later than sixty (60) days after the commencement
 of service, and

24 3. Not later than sixty (60) days after the utility has
25 received approval of its new rate schedule applicable to such

(c) In this subsection, "rate schedule" shall mean customer
charge, energy charge, and demand charge, as set forth in Rule
25-6.100, F.A.C.

5 (d) By bill insert, or as a message on the customer bill, 6 on a quarterly basis using the utility's normal billing cycle. 7 each utility shall provide its customers the sources of generation for the most recent 12-months period available prior 8 9 to the billing cycle. The sources of generation shall be stated by fuel type for utility generation and as "purchased power" for 10 off-system purchases. The sources of generation are to be set 11 forth as kilowatt-hour percentages of the total utility 12 generation and purchased power. 13

(4) Upon request of any customer, but not more frequently than once each calendar year, the utility shall transmit a concise statement of the actual consumption of electric energy by that customer for each billing period during the previous twelve (12) months.
