> RE: Docket No. 990054-WU; Application by Florida Water Services Corporation for amendment of Water Certificate No. 106-W to add and delete territory in Lake County, Florida.

After reviewing the application in the above referenced docket, the staff needs the additional information listed below.

- 1. As required by Section 367.045(1)(a), Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-30.030, Florida Administrative Code (FAC), the utility must provide notice of the application and provide affidavits that the notice was given. The notice must be given to the governmental entities and all utilities in the county, all cities located in the county, and to each of the customers in the proposed territory. The notice must be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the area proposed to be served. The affidavit for the notice to the utilities and the governmental entities, the customers and the newspaper has been filed. The affidavit states the notice was given to the utilities and the governmental entities indicated on the list provided by the Commission, Exhibit O. However, the return receipt cards, Supplemental Appendix O-4, are missing for Crystal River Utilities, Inc., Lake Groves Utilities, Inc., East Central Florida Planning Council, and Mayor, City of Fruitland Park. Please provide a copy of their return receipt cards. If you have not noticed these entities, please call and request a new county list. We have a similar discrepancy for the customers. There are 69 return receipt cards, Supplemental Appendix P-3. However, according to the application the utility noticed 208 customers that are outside of the utility's service area, Appendix P-2. Please explain. If you have any questions about renoticing, please contact Ms. Samantha McRae at (850) 413-6202 or Ms. Alice Crosby at (850) 413-6222 in the Legal Division.
- 2. As Required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(i), FAC, provide one copy of the official county tax assessment map or other map showing Township, range, and section with a scale such as 1"=200" or 1"=400', with the proposed territory plotted thereon by use of metes and bounds. Please plot AquaSource Utility, Inc.'s Haines Creek service area (Attachment A) to determine if there is an

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overlap of territory. Please label all angles and distances on the map. Please determine if there is an overlap and advise.

3. As required by Rule 25-30.036(3)(e), and Rule 25-30.030(2)(b), FAC a territory description needs to be provided. Your territory description may overlap the territory granted to AquaSource Utility, Inc.'s, Haines Creek service area. We have attached that description as Attachment A. Please determine if there is an overlap and advise.

As indicated in the application, the utility is serving outside its certificated territory. Please explain how this happened, how long the utility has been serving outside its certificated territory, why the utility did not file sooner, and what steps the utility has taken to ensure that this situation will not happen again.

Please file an original and twelve copies of the requested information no later than April 30, 1999 with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, FL 32399. Only one territory map is needed.
