#### CASE BACKGROUND

- Pay Telephone Certific te No. 3613 became effective 12/21/93.
- 1997 RAFs Notice mailed 12/11/97 and due 1/30/98.
- USPS returned the notice as "unclaimed." Staff called the telephone number listed in MCD for the company and a recording advised that the number is no longer in service. Staff then called Directory Assistance but no listing was provided.
- Division of Administration advised this company had not paid its 1996 and 1997 RAFs.

Order No. PSC\$1,000 fine and amount by January

- Order No. PSC-98-1692-FOF-TC, issued 12/15/98, imposed a \$1,000 fine and ordered payment of the fine and past due amount by January 12, 1999.
- On 12/28/98, Mr. Denny Golladay, called staff and said he requested cancellation of his certificate by fax in June 1995, therefore, he did not owe RAFs for the years 1996 and 1997. He said he did not keep a copy of his letter. He also asked that the Commission correct the name of his business from Florida Phone to Florida Telephone. He stated he would respond to the Order in writing and enclose his original certificate, which was in the correct name of Florida Telephone.
- Company responded to the Order by letter dated January 2, 1999, and included a copy of his original certificate. (Attachment A) He wrote that he went out of business on 6/5/96, requested cancellation of his certificate at that time, and asked that the name of his business be corrected to reflect the correct name of Florida Telephone.
- Staff received a copy of the company's Original Application (Attachment B) from the Division of Records and Reporting.
   The name on the application is Florida Telephone.
- Order No. PSC-93-1710-FOF-TC, issued 11/29/93, shows the company name as Florida Phone. (Attachment C)
- Department of State, Division of Corporations records show the fictitious name is registered as Florida Phone. (Attachment D)
- The company's 1995 RAF form for the period 1/1/95 to 6/30/95 (Attachment E) shows the r me as Florida Phone. The company signed and dated the form on 6/20/95 and did not correct the name on the line provided. The form reflects that the company had eight (8) payphones in operation.
- The company's 1995 RAF form for the period 7/1/95 to 12/31/95 (Attachment F) shows the name as Florida Phone. However, the company did correct the name to reflect Florida Telephone. The company signed and dated the form on 1/26/96. The form reflects that the company had nine (9) payphones in operation.

Therefore, staff believes the following recommendations are appropriate.

### DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission grant the company a voluntary cancellation of PATS Certificate No. 3613?

RECOMMENDATION: No. The Commission should not grant the company a voluntary cancellation of its PATS certificate. The Commission should involuntarily cancel the company's certificate with an effective date of June 5, 1996. (Isler)

STAFF ANALYSIS: Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, requires the payment of regulatory assessment fees by January 30 of the subsequent year for telecommunications companies, and provides for penalties and interest as outlined in Section 350.113, Florida Statutes, for any delinquent amounts.

The Division of Administration notified staff by memorandum that the company had not submitted the 1996 and 1997 regulatory assessment fees (RAFs), along with the 1996 and 1997 statutory penalty and interest charges.

The United States Postal Service (USPS) returned the 1997 RAF form unopened and stamped "return to sender" and "unclaimed." Staff called the telephone number listed in the Master Commission Directory (MCD) for this company, and received a recording that the number was no longer in service. Staff then called Directory Assistance, but no new listing was provided.

On December 15, 1998, Order No. PSC-98-1692-FOF-TC was issued, which imposed a \$500 fine for the RAFs violation and \$500 for the reporting requirements violation, for a total of \$1,000. The Order required payment of the fines and past due amount by January 12, 1999, or stated the company's certificate would be canceled.

On December 28, 1998, Mr. Denny Golladay, owner, called staff and stated that he had requested voluntary cancellation of his certificate by fax in June 1995, therefore, he did not owe the 1996 and 1997 RAFs. Mr. Golladay also stated that he did not keep a copy of the 1995 letter. Mr. Golladay followed up his telephone call by responding to the Order by letter dated January 2, 1999, which included his original certificate (Attachment A). The letter gave the date he closed his business as June 5, 1996, a year later than the date he verbally told staff. Ordinarily, staff would believe that the company had just verbally given the wrong year except for Mr. Golladay's comment that he did not owe the 1996 RAFs since he went out of business in 1995.

Staff obtained a copy of the two 1995 RAF forms from the Division of Administration. The 1995 RAF form for the period January 1, 1995 to June 30, 1995 (Attachment E) was signed and dated June 20, 1995, which was after the June 5th date Mr. Golladay had given staff. The form indicated that the company had eight (8) payphones in operation during the first half of 1995. The 1995 RAF form for the period July 1, 1995 to December 31, 1995 (Attachment F) was signed and dated January 26, 1996. The form indicated that the company had nine (9) payphones in operation during the last half of 1995. Neither form had a note which stated that he went out of business in June 1995.

Although the Commission imposed a \$1,000 fine for the two rule violations, staff does not believe that payment of the fine would serve any purpose since the company has been out of business for almost three years. Therefore, since the company had nine payphones in operation on December 31, 1995, it is staff's belief that the company is responsible for payment of the 1996 regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges. In addition, since the the 1996 RAFs remain unpaid, staff does not believe it is appropriate to grant the company a voluntary cancellation. Accordingly, the Commission should not grant the company a voluntary cancellation of its PATS certificate. The Commission should involuntarily cancel the company's certificate with an effective date of June 5, 1996.

ISSUE 2: Should the Commission acknowledge the name of the company as Florida Telephone as stated in the company's original application?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should acknowledge the name of the company as Florida Telephone.

STAFF ANALYSIS: During staff's telephone conversation of December 28, 1998, with the company's owner, Mr. Golladay stated that the Commission had "dropped the ball" on the name of his company because his original application was in the name of Florida Telephone, not Florida Phone, and that his original certificate was issued in the correct name of Florida Telephone.

Staff received a copy of the company's original application from the Division of Records and Reporting in Docket No. 930943-TC. Attachment B is the first page of the original application, which showed the name on the application was Florida Telephone. Order No. PSC-93-1710-FOF-TC, issued November 29, 1993, showed the company name as Florida Phone (Attachment C). Staff then obtained the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations' records, which showed the fictitious name was registered as Florida Phone (Attachment D). The company's 1995 RAF form for the period July 1 through December 31, 1995, was printed by the Commission as Florida Phone. However, the company corrected the name to reflect Florida Telephone. (Attachment F)

Normally, before processing applications, the name on the application must match the name registered with the Division of Corporations. At this point in time, staff can only guess what happened to the change in name. Regardless, it is staff's belief that the Commission should acknowledge the name of the company as Florida Telephone.
