## **DISCUSSION OF ISSUES**

Should the Commission suspend Florida Power & Light Company's (FPL) proposed Standard Offer Contract and COG-2 tariff revision?

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:** Yes. The Commission should suspend FPL's proposed Standard Offer Contract and COG-2 tariff revision. (DUDLEY)

STAFF ANALYSIS: In accordance with Section 366.051, Statutes, and Rule 25-17.0832(4), Florida Administrative Code, FPL filed a Petition for Approval of a Standard Offer Contract for qualifying cogeneration and small power production facilities. proposed contract is based on a 5 MW subscription limit of a 209 MW combustion turbine generating unit with an in-service date of 2001. Staff recommends that the proposed tariffs be suspended to allow
