Demonstration of Managerial, Financial, and Technical capabilities:

TranStar is managerially, technically and financially qualified to provide local exchange resale services with the State of Florida.

A. Financial Capabilities

TranStar has adequate access to the financing and capital necessary to conduct its telecommunications operations and possesses the financial qualifications required of applicants for the license requested herein. Attached are the most recent financial statements for TranStar which demonstrate that TranStar possesses the sound financial support necessary to competently and effectively provide the service authority requested by this application.

TranStar has the financial fortitude to provide resold services in the geographic areas proposed to serve, this includes all areas served by Bell South. In addition, as a reseller of residential local exchange service, TranStar will not need capital to build its own network. Rather it will resell the services of the underlying carrier. Transtar has the financial capabilities to lease these services.

Mr. Earles graduated in 1977 for Southeastern Oklahoma State University with a B.A. in Accounting. He has worked in Management and ownership of various business ventures including the animal feed industry, oil field supply, drilling and developing oil and gas wells. He also holds a commercial pilots license. 
