Dear Mr. Fisher:

I am handling your request for cancellation of your certificate in Docket No. 990176-TI. Rule 25-24.474(2)(a), (b), (c), and (d) states:

- (2) If a certificated company desires to cancel its certificate, it shall request cancellation from the Commission in writing and shall provide the following with its request:
 - (a) Statement of intent and date to pay Regulatory Assessment Fee.
 - (b) Statement of why the certificate is proposed to be cancelled.
 - (c) A statement on treatment of customer deposits and final bills.
 - (d) Proof of individual customer notice regarding discontinuance of service.


As discussed in our telephone conversation, I understand that SunNet no longer has any customers, therefore, you do not have to provide the statements required in paragraphs (c) and (d). Since the effective date of the cancellation of your certificate will be in 1999, this means that the 1999 regulatory assessment fee (RAF) will need to be paid. Attached is the 1999 RAF form, which will need to be completed and returned to the Commission, along with your \$50 check. Or, you may write the Commission and provide the date that you will pay the 1999 RAF.

If SunNet did not have any customers in 1999, I can make the effective date of the cancellation in 1998. This means that you would not owe the 1999 RAF. Let me know if that is the case.
