

At the April 20, 1999, Agenda Conference, the Commission approved the involuntary cancellation of the certificate in the above-referenced docket. On April 23, 1999, the company provided staff with a copy of the request for voluntary cancellation, dated October 25, 1998. Although we have no record of receiving this correspondence at the time specified on the request, the company has provided staff with the required proof of the request for cancellation.

Staff has filed a recommendation for the May 18, 1999, Agenda Conference to address the company's request for voluntary cancellation of the certificate.

For the reasons described above, the Order involuntarily canceling the certificate, due to be filed on May 10, 1999, will not be issued. Upon the disposition of this matter on the May 18th Agenda, an order consistent with the Commission's decision will be issued.
