<u>Issue 2</u>: What rates and charges should be approved for Plantation Landings, Ltd.?

Recommendation: The rates and charges detailed in the analysis portion of staff's May 6, 1999 memorandum for Plantation Landings, Ltd., should be approved. The tariff sheets effective November 30, 1998 pursuant to the 1998 pass-through rate adjustment should supersede those filed in this docket. All other tariff provisions should be made effective on or after the stamped approval date.

<u>Issue 3</u>: Should Plantation Landings, Ltd., be responsible for regulatory assessment fees commencing December 1, 1998?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes, Plantation Landings, Ltd., should be responsible for regulatory assessment fees commencing December 1, 1998. The utility should be required to remit the resulting 1998 RAFs within 30 days from the date of the order in this docket.

<u>Issue 4</u>: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes, upon the expiration of the protest period, the docket should be closed if no timely protest to the proposed agency action issue is filed.
