STORMTEL, INC. f/k/a Z-TEL, INC. ("STORMTEL"), by its attorneys, hereby notifies the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") of the proposed transfer of control of STORMTEL from its current shareholders to CCC Merger Corp. through the sale of all of STORMTEL's corporate stock. It is our understanding that under the circumstances set forth below, no formal approval of the Commission is required for this transaction.

STORMTEL, a Nevada corporation, is currently authorized to provide intrastate toll telecommunication services in Florida.¹ STORMTEL is currently authorized as a reseller of intrastate, interexchange telecommunications services in 47 states. It also is authorized by the Federal Communications Commission to resell interstate and international service.

On December 31, 1998, Progressive Telecommunications Corporation ("Progressive") and the shareholders of STORMTEL, entered into a Merger Agreement whereby CCC Merger Corp., a wholly owned subsidiary of Progressive, will acquire 100 percent of the issued and outstanding capital stock of STORMTEL's parent corporation, CCC Communications Corp.

The transfer of control of STORMTEL from its current shareholders to CCC Merger Corp. is in the public interest. The addition of STORMTEL to CCC Merger Corp.'s other interests will enhance both CCC Merger Corp. and STORMTEL's ability to compete in the market for telecommunication services in Florida and elsewhere. The benefit from increased economies of scale will permit STORMTEL to operate more efficiently and thus to compete more effectively.
