BellSouth has received a copy of ITC^DeltaCom's letter to you dated June 24. 1999, regarding ITC^DeltaCom's consent to waiver of the statutory time frame set forth in Section 252(b)(4)(C) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 with respect to the above-referenced docket. This letter is to notify the Florida Public Service Commission that BellSouth also consents to the Commission Staff's requested waiver and to resolution of the Arbitration outside of such statutory time frame.

Although BellSouth consents to the extension of time for the Commission to render a decision in this Arbitration, it is BellSouth's position that ITC^DeltaCom's request for an extension of the current Interconnection Agreement is unnecessary and BellSouth is opposed to any amendment to such effect. Section XVII(C) of the current Interconnection Agreement between the parties clearly provides that upon expiration of the agreement (i.e., June 30, 1999), the parties will continue to operate in accordance with the terms of such agreement until such time as a new interconnection agreement becomes effective. When the new interconnection agreement becomes effective, the terms of the new agreement shall be applied retroactively to the date of expiration of the prior agreement. It appears that ITC^DeltaCom's request to extend the expiration date of the current agreement is merely an attempt to avoid application of the terms and conditions of the new agreement to the period between June 30, 1999, and the date the new agreement becomes effective. Since the current Interconnection Agreement between the parties OTH

clearly addresses the circumstances about which ITC^DeltaCom is concerned, no extension of the term of the current Interconnection Agreement is needed.
