<u>Issue 2</u>: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: No. If staff's recommendation in Issue 1 is approved, this docket should remain open pending remittance of the \$12,000 voluntary contribution which is to be paid in six equal monthly installments beginning August 1, 1999, and ending January 1, 2000. Upon remittance of the final settlement payment, this docket should be closed. Each settlement payment of \$2,000 should be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If USA fails to make all payments in accordance with the terms in its settlement offer, Certificate Number 3491 shall be canceled. If the certificate is canceled accordingly, any installment payments previously made are non-returnable.
