

Chapter 62-552, Florida Administrative Code (FAC), requires the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) to determine whether FDEP decisions pursuant to providing a State Revolving Fund (SRF) loan for the construction of water management facilities will have a significant adverse impact on the environment. One such decision is the approval of a facilities plan, or portion of such facilities plan, for projects that may be financed under the SRF loan program. The FDEP, in making this determination, assumes that all facilities and actions recommended in the planning documents justifying these facilities will be implemented, whether or not SRF loan assistance is used to fund any of those facilities or actions.

The proposed work involves the construction of improvements to the existing water system as shown on the attached Figures 1 and 2. The total estimated project cost is \$124,000.

The FDEP tentatively finds, based on a review of the recently submitted "Residential Water Systems, Inc. Water Facilities Plan", that the above described work is eligible for categorical exclusion from a detailed environmental review under the criteria in Rule 62-552.700(3)(c), FAC. This Florida Categorical Exclusion Notification does not commit any regulatory agency to issue permits that may be required for construction of the facilities.

If public comments are submitted within 30 days of the date of this notice to Jun Tabanguil, Bureau of Water Facilities Funding, Department of Environmental Protection, Mail Station #3505, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, indicating that the proposed facilities or actions recommended in the planning documents will adversely affect the environment, this determination can be revoked. 


