3	CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Good afternoon. We're
4	going to counsel, why don't you read the notice.
5	MR. ELIAS: Notice issued by the Clerk of
6	the Florida Public Service Commission on July 22,
7	1999, advises that this time and place have been
8	reserved for a prehearing conference in Docket Nos.
9	971004, 971005, 971006, 971007-EG. Those proceedings
10	are designed to establish numeric conservation goals
11	for Florida Power and Light Company, Florida Power
12	Corporation, Gulf Power Company, and Tampa Electric
13	Company, respectively.
14	CHAIRMAN GARCIA: We'll take appearances.
15	MR. GUYTON: My name is Charles Guyton with
16	the law firm of Steel, Hector and Davis, 215 South
17	Monroe Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32301, appearing
18	on behalf of Florida Power and Light Company in Docket
19	No. 971004.
20	MR. BADDERS: Russell Badders, appearing on
21	behalf of Gulf Power Company. I'm with the law firm
22	of Beggs & Lane. I'm appearing in the Docket 971006.
23	MR. McGEE: James McGee, P. O. Box 14042,
24	St. Petersburg 33733, appearing on behalf of Florida
25	Power Corporation in Docket No. 971005.

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MR. BEASLEY: James D. Beasley with the law 1 firm of Ausley, McMullen, P. O. Box 391, Tallahassee, 2 Flroida 32302, and I'm representing Tampa Electric 3 Company in Docket No. 971007. 4 MS. KAUFMAN: Vicki Gordon Kaufman of the 5 6 McWhirter Reeves law firm, 117 South Gadsden Street, Tallahasse, 32301. I'm appearing on behalf of the 7 Florida Industrial Power Users Group in all four 8 dockets. 9 I'm Debra Swim. I'm representing MS. SWIM: 10 LEAF. We've withdrawn from the 971004 through 006 11 dockets and remain a party in the 007 docket, but 12 intend to withdraw as soon as we get a chance to. 13 We just got a copy of the Order in that docket today. 14 MR. ELIAS: Robert V. Elias representing the 15 Commission Staff. 16 CHAIRMAN GARCIA: I understand that there 17 is -- there are no preliminary matters? 18 MR. ELIAS: That's my understanding, unless 19 20 the parties have something to raise. CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Let's go through the --21 22 MR. ELIAS: Mr. Chairman --CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Prehearing Order. 23 MR. ELIAS: Everyone should have in front of 24 them a copy of the Prehearing Order that has got two 25

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stamped "drafts" on the first page, and one printed "draft" so that we're all looking at the same version. And it is identical to some previous versions, with some changes that I've shared with the parties.

5 We learned late last week that there was a 6 Commissioner who had some questions of the witnesses, 7 and in prior drafts of the Prehearing Order that was 8 not reflected.

After subsequent conversations with that 9 Commissioner, we have no need to question witnesses 10 tomorrow. So it would be our expectation that the 11 issued Prehearing Order will reflect the fact that all 12 witnesses have been excused; that all prefiled 13 testimony and exhibits will be introduced into the 14 record, and the case will be presented to the panel as 15 a stipulation -- or to the Commission as a 16 17 stipulation.

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CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Okay.

MR. ELIAS: And to my knowledge there are no
other matters that require the attention of the
Prehearing Officer at this time.

CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Okay.

23 MS. KAUFMAN: I just have a correction or 24 addition I'd like to make to the prehearing statement. 25 That's on Page 24, under Item 10, where it

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says "all issues have been stipulated." I would just 1 ask that the Prehearing Order reflect that FIPUG takes 2 no position on the stipulations. We were not a 3 signatory to them, so I'd like the Prehearing Order to 4 reflect that. We don't object, but I just want to 5 reflect that we have no position. Is that all right 6 7 with everyone? MR. ELIAS: We have no problem with that. 8 MS. SWIM: Chairman Garcia, I just want to 9 make sure the record is clear. As is stated in our 10 stipulation, we are not taking a position on the 11 utility goals proposal. 12 MR. ELIAS: We can reflect that fact in this 13 section of the Prehearing Order as well. 14 CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Withdrawing --. 15 MS. SWIM: Yes. We, upon the stipulations 16 being approved by the Commission, agreed to withdraw, 17 but that was conditioned on us taking a "no position" 18 on the --19 CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Okay. All right. There 20 are no pending motions. So there's no rulings 21 required and no confidential request cited. 22 All right. Mr. Elias, anything else we need 23 to do? 24 MR. ELIAS: Not that I'm aware of. 25

5	CHAIRMAN GARCIA: We were going to do

11	CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Let me make it safe.
12	That's not being safe. Let me just say this: When
13	we're supposed to convene tomorrow at Agenda tomorrow
14	at 9:30 we're opening up the Call Center tomorrow.
15	I'll handle that for the first 30 minutes. And we
16	will take this up before we open Agenda. Since we're
17	all here, I don't think there's any surprise
18	discussion. We'll take this up first, and we'll
19	hopefully vote it out right then and there. And then
20	we'll proceed into agenda. If somebody has something
21	to say, all bets are off. We'll TP it until after
22	Agenda.
23	MS. SWIM: So does that mean 9:30 or 9:00?
24	CHAIRMAN GARCIA: 9:30. That way we all
25	know where we are. And it won't is that all right

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1 || with everyone?

MR. ELIAS: Yes. 2 CHAIRMAN GARCIA: Because if I tell you 3 9:00, we're not going to start at 9:00 -- you're going 4 to end up here anyway. Let's just get you all here in 5 the room at the same time.
