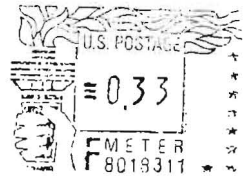
NOTICE OF FURTHER PROCEEDINGS OR JUDICIAL REVIEW
