BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC.'S NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL OF TESTIMONY AND FILING OF REVISED TESTIMONY

BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth") respectfully gives notice that it is withdrawing two pages of the testimony of Alphonso Varner, as well as Exhibit AJV-1 to Mr. Varner's testimony, and is hereby filing revised pages (12, 12A, and 68) and revised Exhibit AJV-1 in their place. These revisions are necessary in order to more accurately reflect the issues that are the subject of this arbitration and to correctly reflect elements for which this Commission has already established cost-based rates.

In its petition for arbitration, ITC^DeltaCom raised the following issue: "What should be the appropriate rate for cageless/shared collocation in light of the recent FCC Advanced Services Order?" Arbitration Petition, Issue 6(d). This issue was one of many addressed by Mr. Varner in his testimony. After the testimony was filed with the Commission, however, BellSouth discovered that Exhibit AJV-1 inadvertently contained proposed interim rates for collocation elements that were unrelated to cageless or shared collocation. These rate

elements should not have been included in Exhibit AJV-1 or referenced in Mr. Varner's testimony. The revised pages and revised Exhibit AJV-1 that BellSouth is filing herewith correct this error.

As originally filed, Exhibit AJV-1 also omitted the reciprocal compensation rates established by this Commission in Docket Nos. 960757-TP, 960833-TP, and 960846-TP. The revised Exhibit AJV-1 corrects this error as well.

BellSouth regrets any inconvenience that it has caused the Commission or ITC^DeltaCom.

8		an issue in its Petition for Arbitration are included in Exhibit AJV-1 attached to
9		my testimony. The source of the rate is generally denoted by the date of the
10		Commission's Orders in the arbitration proceedings ("4/29/98 Order" or
11		"12/31/96 Order"). There are certain elements requested by ITC^DeltaCom in
12		its Petition, for which this Commission has not previously approved rates. The
13		term "Cost Study" is used to denote the rates that are being proposed for such
14		elements, based on the new cost studies that have been filed in this proceeding.
15		
16		Finally, in order for BellSouth to meet the requirements of the FCC's recent
17		Advanced Services Order as it relates to the provision of collocation,
18		BellSouth will file with this Commission a complete cost study for Security
19		Access Systems that will be conducted using the cost methodology and inputs
20		specified by this Commission in its April 29, 1998 Order. In the meantime,
21		BellSouth proposes that the appropriate rate for Security Access Systems is the
22		rate for "Physical Collocation - Security Access System - New Access Card
23		Activation, per request - 5 cards", as approved by this Commission in its April
24		29, 1998 Order. This approved rate is included in Exhibit AJV-1, attached to

1	A. Yes. The rates BellSouth proposes for collocation are contained in Exhibit
2	AJV-1 attached to my testimony. Rates for many of the collocation element
3	were approved by the Commission in its April 29, 1998 Orders (Cost Ref. #
4	H.1.1 - H.1.19). To order cageless and shared collocation, ITC^DeltaCom
5	would simply order the amount of floor space necessary for their collocation
