CASE BACKGROUND

- 09/15/95 This company obtained Florida Public Service Commission PATS Certificate No. 4245.
- 12/10/98 The Division of Administration mailed the regulatory assessment fee (RAF) notice. In accordance with Florida Statute 350.113(4), the Commission "shall provide each regulated company with written notice of the date that payment of the fee is due at least 45 days prior to such date", which would put the due date to February 1, 1999. Records show that this company had not paid its 1998 RAF.

• 08/31/99 - Ms. Elizabeth Gaynor, Owner, called staff and advised that she would pay the past due amount and make a settlement offer to resolve this case.

• 09/07/99 - At the Agenda Conference, the Commission voted to fine the company \$500 or cancel its certificate. On this same date, the company paid the past due amount in full and proposed to pay a settlement of \$100 and pay future fees on a timely basis.

DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

<u>ISSUE 1</u>: Should the Commission accept the settlement offer proposed by Elizabeth J. Gaynor, to resolve the apparent violation of Rule 25-4.0161, Florida Administrative Code, Regulatory Assessment Fees; Telecommunications Companies?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should accept the company's settlement proposal. Any contribution should be received by the Commission within ten business days from the date of the Commission Order and should identify the docket number and company name. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the company fails to pay in accordance with the terms of the Commission Order, the company's certificate should be canceled administratively. (Isler)

STAFF ANALYSIS: On August 31, 1999, Ms. Elizabeth Gaynor, the company's owner, called staff and advised she would pay the past due fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, and make a settlement offer. After the September 7 Agenda Conference, at which the Commission voted to fine the company \$500 or cancel its certificate, staff received the company's payment of its past regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges, and settlement proposal in the amount of \$100.

Accordingly, staff believes the terms of the settlement agreement as summarized in this recommendation should be accepted. Any contribution should be received by the Commission within ten business days from the date of the Commission Order and should identify the docket number and company name. The Commission should forward the contribution to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the State General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes. If the company fails to pay in accordance with the terms of the Commission Order, the company's certificate should be canceled administratively.
