This is a follow up to our telephone conversation concerning the past due regulatory assessment fees, including statutory penalty and interest charges. As I explained in our telephone conversation, in order to keep your certificate active, you need to pay the past due amount in full and make a settlement offer. If your check is postmarked in September, the minimum amount due is the \$50.00 regulatory assessment fee, \$12.50 penalty, and \$4.00 interest, for a total of \$66.50. If your check is postmarked in October, the minimum amount due is the \$50.00 regulatory assessment fee, \$12.50 penalty, and \$4.50 interest, for a total of \$67.00. However, since the amount of the regulatory assessment fee is based on revenue, I am attaching the form to be completed and returned with your check.

There is normally a \$500 fine associated with this rule violation. In other, similar cases, the Commission has accepted a \$100 settlement in lieu of the \$500 fine which is scheduled for the October 5 Agenda Conference. Your letter needs to include the docket number and state that you have taken steps to prevent this from happening in the future and make a specific monetary settlement. The Order imposing the \$500 fine is scheduled to be issued around October 25 and you would then have 21 days to either protest the Order or make a settlement offer. However, if you wished, you could go ahead and make the settlement offer. Any settlement offer should be addressed to Ms. Blanca Bayó, Director, Division of Records and Reporting, Florida Public Service Commission, at the above address.
