<u>Issue 2</u>: Should Tampa Electric Company implement a mid-course correction to its current Environmental Cost Recovery Clause factors to reflect the costs of the two new programs?

<u>Recommendation</u>: No. The prudently incurred costs for the two programs should be included in the true-up filings for the period. The costs should be allocated to the rate classes on an energy basis.

## **APPROVED**

<u>Issue 3:</u> Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes.
