Issue 1:

SFNG's Position:

\$26,970 overrecovery.

Issue 2:

What is the estimated purchased gas adjustment true-up amount for the

period January, 1999 through December, 1999?

SFNG's Position:

\$115,104 overrecovery.

Issue 3:

What is the total purchased gas adjustment true-up amount to be collected

in the January, 2000 - December, 2000 period?

SFNG's Position:

\$142,074 overrecovery.

Issue 4:

What is the appropriate levelized purchased gas cost recovery (cap) factor

to be charged during the period January, 1999 through December, 1999?

SFNG's Position:

31.066 cents per therm.

Issue 5:

What should be the effective date of the new purchased gas adjustment

charge for billing purposes?
