Dear Sirs:

We are in receipt of your most recent correspondence dated September 21, 1999, regarding the above referenced matter.

We would like to take this opportunity to try and explain a situation that we were not even aware of In 1995, there was a gentleman who was leasing office space from us and approached us regarding a partnership which involved pay telephone services. We agreed and utilized one of our corporations for this partnership. A few months later the partnership ended abruptly, and to say the least we did not stop to think of any open issues.

There were never any pay telephones installed under a certificate issued to Printemps, Inc., the fee of \$50.00 was paid inadvertently for 1996 and 1997. Our accounting department pays the invoices for all of the companies, and normally all invoices are authorized except the ones for state and government. These bills are paid immediately and without question.

We moved our main office from Deerfield Beach to Margate in April of 1998, so we probably did not receive the renewal or notice of fee at our new address. I have enclosed a copy of your envelope that shows that your certified letter was forwarded by the new owner of 441 S Federal Highway, Deerfield Beach.

We hope that you will reconsider the penalty for non-payment and cancel the certificate since Printemps, Inc. has never engaged in any business that requires this type of Certificate.

We look forward to hearing from you regarding the above matter, and apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused.


