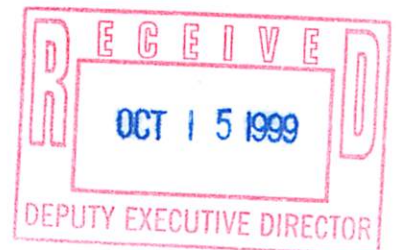

On August 12, 1999, BellSouth and Global Interactive Communications Corporation filed their negotiated resale agreement. The agreement is scheduled to be addressed at the Commission's October 19, 1999, Agenda as Item No. 26. We ask that this item be deferred from this agenda.
