18	need to be made on some of the positions, but I			
19	believe that all the issues that we are in			
20	agreement on all of the issues. If there aren't any			
21	preliminary matters we could probably just go through			
22	the draft Prehearing Order.			
23	COMMISSIONER CLARK: All right. Are there			
24	any preliminary matters in the 03 docket? I don't see			
25	any. It appeared to me that 01 is a stipulated			
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issue -- could be stipulated. 1 MR. KEATING: Issue 1? Yes. I believe that 2 Sebring needs to add its position on that issue. 3 MR. SELF: Commissioner Clark, Sebring Gas 4 agrees with Staff on Issue 1. 5 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. That's 1,452 6 7 underrecovery? 8 MR. SELF: That's correct. 9 COMMISSIONER CLARK: So we can show shall Issue 1 stipulated. 10 Issue 2. I think it's Sebring again we need 11 to hear from. 12 MR. SELF: Sebring again agrees with Staff 13 on Issue 1. 14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Issue 2, that 15 16 was the one we were on. 17 MR. SELF: I'm sorry. That was Issue 2. COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Issue 3. 18 MR. SELF: On Issue 3 Sebring also agrees 19 20 with Staff. COMMISSIONER CLARK: All right. Issue 4. 21 22 MR. SELF: On Issue 4 Sebring's position is 52.724 cents per therm. 23 COMMISSIONER CLARK: So we don't have a 24 stipulation on that and also City Gas is different, 25

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too? 1 MR. SELF: I believe Staff has a revision to 2 3 its position. COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Mr. Keating. 4 MR. KEATING: We are in agreement with City 5 Gas and we are also in agreement with Sebring. Staff 6 is changing its position on Sebring on Issue 4 to 7 52.724 cents per therm. 8 COMMISSIONER CLARK: And for City Gas, which 9 one is it? Is it the 48? Have I got that right? 10 MR. KEATING: I believe we're in agreement 11 on the second number in City Gas' position, the 49.002 12 13 cents per therm. COMMISSIONER CLARK: Oh, I'm sorry. Okay. 14 MR. KEATING: After regulatory assessment 15 16 fees. COMMISSIONER CLARK: All right. So there's 17 a stipulation on Issue 4. 18 Issue 5, is there a stipulation? 19 MR. SELF: For Issue 5, Commissioner Clark, 20 Sebring also agrees with Staff. 21 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. So all the 22 issues are stipulated in the 03 docket. 23 MR. KEATING: That's correct. 24 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Then I guess I would 25

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propose we -- unless you hear from other Commissioners 1 that they want to have the witnesses present, if no 2 one requests that, they will be excused and we'll 3 4 simply take up the stipulation and move its approval 5 at the beginning of the hearing. MR. KEATING: That will be reflected in the 6 7 Prehearing Order. And could I suggest a date by which 8 we'll notify the parties as of Monday November 15th, 9 which is one week prior to hearing. COMMISSIONER CLARK: That's fine. 10 Okay. And you'll let the other Commissioners know that we 11 12 need to hear from them if they want witnesses to be 13 present? MR.
