Issue 2: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: If staff's recommendation in Issue 1 is approved, then U.S. Republic will have 21 days from issuance of the Commission's show cause order to respond in writing why it should not be fined in the amount proposed or have its certificate canceled. If U.S. Republic timely responds to the show cause order, this docket should remain open pending resolution of the show cause proceeding. If the fine is paid, it should be forwarded to the Office of the Comptroller for deposit in the General Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 364.285(1), Florida Statutes, and this docket should be closed. Staff recommends that if U.S. Republic fails to respond to the Order to Show Cause, and the fine is not received within ten business days after expiration of the show cause response period, U.S. Republic's certificate should be canceled and this docket closed.
