This is a follow up to our telephone conversation concerning the past due regulatory assessment fees (RAFs), including statutory penalty and interest charges. If your client wants to keep the pay telephone certificate active, the company must pay the past due amount in full. According to Commission records, the 1998 RAFs have not yet been paid, which were due 2/1/99, therefore penalty and interest charges are also applicable. The amount due is based on intrastate revenues; however, the minimum due is the \$50.00 fee, \$12.50 penalty, and \$5.00 interest, for a total of \$67.50. The 1998 RAF form is attached. However, our records show that Walk-In paid more than the minimum for the year 1997 (the company reported revenues of \$164,551).

In addition to paying the past due amount, if the company wants to keep the certificate active, it must make a settlement offer. In other, similar cases, the Commission has accepted // a \$100 settlement in lieu of the \$500 fine normally imposed for this rule violation. The settlement letter needs to include the docket number, state that it has taken steps to prevent this rule violation from happening in the future, make a specific monetary settlement, and state that the past due amount has since been paid (after you have done so, of course). Any settlement offer should be addressed to Ms. Blanca Bayó, Director, Division of Records and Reporting, Florida Public Service Commission, at the above address. Please respond by November 30, 1999. As information, the proposed settlement amount should not be paid at this time. It will become due after the Commissioners vote on this issue.
