FIRST REQUEST FOR EXTENSION OF CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF MATERIALS PROVIDED IN THECOST ALLOCATION BETWEEN FPL AND FPL SERVICES AUDIT, AUDIT CONTROL NO. 97-223-4-1

NOW, BEFORE THIS COMMISSION, through undersigned counsel, comes Florida Power & Light Company ("FPL") and, pursuant to rule 25-22.006 of the Florida Administrative Code and section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes, hereby submits its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification of certain materials provided to the Florida Public Service Commission ("FPSC" or "Commission") staff ("Staff") in connection with the cost allocation between FPL and FPL Services audit, Audit Control No. 97-223-4-1 (hereinafter the "Audit"). In support of its Request, FPL states as follows:

- 2. On February 6, 1998, FPL filed with the Commission its Request for Confidential Classification of certain materials obtained during the Audit. FPL's initial filing consists of the Request for Confidential Classification and Exhibits A through F. On March 30, 1998, FPL filed with the Commission its Request for Confidential Classification of portions of the Staff's Audit report ("Audit Report"). FPL's March 30, 1998 filing consists of Exhibits A through F.
- 3. By Order No. PSC-98-0931-CFO-EI, dated July 8, 1998, the Commission granted in part FPL's two requests.
- 4. The period of confidential treatment granted by the Commission will soon expire. Much of the information that was the subject of FPL's February 6, 1998 Request and its March 30, 1998 warrants continued treatment as proprietary and confidential business information within the meaning of Section 366.093. Accordingly, FPL hereby submits its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification.
- 5. Except as expressly noted below, FPL incorporates herein by reference Exhibits A and B from its February 6, 1998 filing and Exhibits A and B from its March 30, 1998 filing.
- 6. Included herewith and made a part hereof are Exhibits A1, B1, C and D. Exhibit C identifies the information that FPL contends is entitled to an extension of confidential classification. Exhibit C also reflects the information for which confidential classification is no longer requested. Such information is indicated in boldface and italicized type on Exhibit C to this Request. Accordingly, these referenced work papers should be removed from Exhibits A and B as filed February 6, 1998, and from Exhibits A and B of the March 30, 1998 filing.
- 7. Amended Exhibit C also contains revisions indicating that with respect to certain work papers, or portions thereof, FPL has narrowed its request for confidential classification. Specifically,

- FPL has narrowed its request for confidential classification with respect to work papers no. 44-3/4-2, 44-3/5-1/12-4/3, 45-10/2-3, and 45/10/2-23.
 - 8. Exhibits A1 and B1 contain the work papers referenced above in paragraph 7 for which FPL has narrowed its request for confidential classification. In the work papers comprising Exhibit A1, the information that FPL asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted. Exhibit A1 is submitted separately in a sealed folder marked "Confidential." The highlighted work papers contained in Exhibit A1 replace the work papers of the same identification number included in Exhibit A in FPL's February 6, 1998 filing. FPL requests that the replaced pages of the original Exhibit A in its February 6, 1998 filing, at the Commission's option, be destroyed or returned to FPL.
 - 9. In Exhibit B1, the information for which FPL seeks confidential treatment on the amended work papers has been blocked out. The work papers contained in Exhibit B1 replace the work papers of the same identification number or reference included in Exhibit B in FPL's February 6,1998 filing.
 - 10. Exhibit D includes the affidavits of Rick Del Cueto, Mark Mitchell, Dennis Brandt and John Haney.
 - Pursuant to section 366.093, FPL seeks confidential classification of the information highlighted in Exhibit A as filed in 1998, as hereby amended.
 - 12. FPL submits that such information is proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3). Pursuant to section 366.093, such materials are entitled to confidential treatment and are exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.

- The statutory bases for FPL's assertion of confidentiality with regard to each document or portion thereof are set forth in the Justification Table under the column titled "FLORIDA STATUTE 366.093(3)." The letters (a) through (f) refer to subsections of section 366.093(3), as applicable. Support for FPL's Request for Confidential Classification of the referenced material is provided through the affidavits of John Haney, Mark Mitchell, Dennis Brandt and Rick Del Cueto. The Justification Table identifies the affiant attesting to the basis for FPL's assertion of confidentiality with regard to each document or portion thereof.
- 14. Upon a finding by the Commission that the material in Exhibit A of the February 6, 1998 filing, as amended by Exhibit A1, and Exhibit A of the March 30,1 998 filing, for which FPL seeks confidential treatment continues to be proprietary confidential business information within the meaning of section 366.093(3). Pursuant to section 366.093(4) such materials should not be declassified for the additional periods of confidentiality established by the Commission and should be returned to FPL as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials and affidavits included herewith or incorporated herein by reference, Florida Power & Light Company respectfully requests that its First Request for Extension of Confidential Classification be granted.
