FPC has filed a Request for Confidential Classification for part of document No. **09057-99**. This document is FPC's Response to Staff's First Set of Interrogatories in Docket No. 981890-EU, the Reserve Margin docket.

FPC asserts that part of DN 09057-99 contains proprietary information which, if disclosed, would enable competitors to determine the forecasted reliability of FPC's system. FPC states that, for this reason, disclosure of this information would impair FPC's ability to compete with other entities operating in Florida but not subject to the same reporting requirements as utilities under the Commission's grid bill jurisdiction pursuant to Section 366.05(7), Florida Statutes.

Attached is a copy of the redacted pages from DN 09057-99. Also attached is a table containing FPC's reason for requesting confidentiality for these pages, along with staff's recommendation for each request.

Staff recommends that FPC's request be denied in total. Specific reasons for denying FPC's request are included in the attached table.

The Florida Reliability Coordinating Council (FRCC), Inc. filed a Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 11680-99. The document is in response to Staff's Second Set of Interrogatories in Docket No. 981890-EU, the Reserve Margin Docket. The nature of the information submitted is aggregate Peninsular Florida daily available capacity assessments for each day for the last two years.

The FRCC asserts that all of the information contained in its response to Staff's Interrogatory No. 20 is proprietary confidential business information under Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes. The FRCC states that the disclosure of this information would impair the competitive business of its members and provide competitors in the wholesale market for power an undue advantage.

Staff is already in possession of approximately two dozen of the individual assessments. The FRCC simply provided peninsula summary assessments for a two year period. In fact, the two dozen assessments staff is already in possession of include individual utility data in addition to the aggregate peninsula summary. Considering that part of the information the FRCC seeks to be held confidential is already in the possession of staff, and that the remaining information is of the same type, staff recommends that the FRCC's request be denied.

A redacted copy was not provided by the FRCC.

# COMMENTS OF THE JEA

JEA has reviewed the **Topics of Discussion** discussed at the January 25, 1999 staff workshop. JEA has also reviewed the Florida Reliability Coordinating Council, Inc. (FRCC) comments to the above docket, and hereby submits the following as additional comments:

JEA 's non-firm load consists of 5% curtailable and 95% direct control, interruptible load in the Summer; 10% curtailable and 90% direct control, interruptible load in the Winter.

### Reasonableness of capping non-firm Load

JEA agrees that there should be a capping of non-firm load. JEA has implemented a 200 MW non-coincident peak cap. The coincident cap equates to approximately 150 MW in the Summer and 100 MW in the Winter of 1999 with a 2% growth of that contracted non-firm load. JEA has found this to be a reasonable cap to date for its customers. JEA plans to monitor and track the appropriateness of this cap.

### Frequency and duration of interruptions

On August 27<sup>th</sup> 1998, a training aircraft based at Cecil Field Naval Air Station crashed into the two 500 kV transmission lines coming into the state from Georgia. The crash took the transmission lines out of service immediately. The damage isolated JEA and other major Florida utilities from the North American electric grid.

In order to supply adequate electricity to the firm customers in our service area, the first and only interruption of electric service occurred under our Interruptible/Curtailable Service contracts. Approximately 30 large commercial and industrial customers were without electricity for a little over two hours. No firm service customers lost service.

JEA's current Interruptible and Curtailable Service Agreements do not restrict the frequency or the duration of interruptions.

### Minimum non-firm notice provisions to return to firm

Under the JEA Interruptible and Curtailable Service Agreements service shall be for a minimum initial term of 3 years from the commencement of service. Customers desiring to terminate service under this rate schedule and/or transfer to a firm rate schedule are required to give the JEA a minimum of thirty-six (36) months notice prior to the transfer. For contracts executed prior to December 31, 1997, the JEA may waive this notice requirement upon JEA's determination that there is sufficient capacity to provide firm service to the customer and that allowing the customer to receive firm service will have no adverse effect on the JEA's availability of providing firm service to JEA's existing and projected firm customers for the early termination period. For contracts executed after December 31, 1997, if the Customer elects to terminate this Agreement by furnishing JEA with less than thirty-six (36) months written notice, Customer shall pay an amount equal to 36 months of General Service Large Demand (GSLD) rate demand charges, or execute a General Service Large Demand Rider Electric Service Agreement (GSLDR-5).

### 5. Price Spikes

JEA does not plan to interrupt firm load to avoid a costly purchase.

Under JEA's Interruptible Service Agreement, service is subject to interruption during any time period that electric power and energy delivered from the JEA's available generating resources is required to:

(a) maintain service to the JEA's firm power customers and firm power sales commitments, or

- (b) supply emergency interchange service to another utility for its firm load obligations only, or
- (c) when the price of power available to JEA from other sources exceeds \$300 per MWh.

Customers under this agreement may elect to have the JEA minimize interruptions as described above by purchasing power from other sources during periods of normal interruption (buy through).

JEA does not plan to interrupt firm or non-firm load to make discretionary sales to others.




