- Issue 3: Are FPUC's proposed goals based upon an adequate assessment of the market segments and major end-use categories pursuant to Rule 25-17.0021(3), Florida Administrative Code?
- <u>Issue 4</u>: What should be FPUC's annual residential winter and summer kW and annual residential kWh conservation goals for the period 2001-2010?
- <u>Issue 5</u>: What should be FPUC's annual commercial/industrial winter and summer kW and annual commercial/industrial kWh conservation goals for the period 2001-2010?
