Pursuant to Order No. PSC-99-2135-PCO-EG, issued October 28, 1999, establishing the prehearing procedure in this docket, the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission hereby files its Preliminary Issue Statement.

- Is the planning process and data used by Orlando Issue 1: Utilities Commission (OUC) in evaluating demand-side measures reasonable?
- Do OUC's proposed goals adequately reflect consideration of overlapping measures, rebound effects, free riders, interactions with building codes and appliance efficiency standards, and OUC's latest monitoring and evaluation of conservation programs and measures?
- OUC's proposed goals based upon an Issue 3: Are assessment of the market segments and major end-use categories pursuant to Rule 25-17.0021(3), Florida Administrative Code?
- What should be OUC's annual residential winter and summer Issue 4: kW and annual residential kWh conservation goals for the period 2001-2010?
- What should be OUC's annual commercial/industrial winter Issue 5: and summer kW and annual commercial/industrial kWh conservation goals for the period 2001-2010?
