PETITION OF SPRINT-FLORIDA, INCORPORATED FOR APPROVAL OF AMENDMENT TO INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT BETWEEN SPRINT-FLORIDA, INC. AND MCImetro ACCESS TRANSMISSION SERVICES, LLC

Sprint-Florida, Incorporated (Sprint-Florida) files this Petition with the Florida Public Service Commission seeking approval of an amendment to the Interconnection Agreement which Sprint-Florida has entered into with MCImetro Access Transmission (MCIm). In support of this Petition, Sprint-Florida states:

- 1. Florida Telecommunications law. Chapter 364, Florida Statutes as amended, requires local exchange carriers such as Sprint-Florida to negotiate "mutually acceptable prices, terms and conditions of interconnection and for the resale of services and facilities" with alternative local exchange carriers. Section 364.162, Florida Statutes (1996).
- 2. Telecommunications Act of 1996, requires that any such "agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration shall be submitted for approval to the State commission" 47 U.S.C. §252(e).

- 3. In accordance with the above provisions, Sprint Florida, Inc. entered an Agreement with MCIm which is a carrier certificated as an alternative local exchange carrier as that term is defined in Section 364.02(1), Florida Statutes. The original Agreement was filed with the Commission on April 16, 1997. The amendment was executed on December 15, 1999.
- 4. Under the Federal Act, an agreement (or amendment there to) can be rejected by the State commission only if the commission finds that it discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or if the implementation of that agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. 47 U.S.C. §252(e)(2).
- 5. The amendment to the Original Agreement with MCIm does not discriminate against other similarly situated carriers which may order services and facilities from 5print-Florida under similar terms and conditions. The Agreement is also consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. As such, Sprint-Florida seeks approval of the Amendment to the Agreement from the Florida Public Service Commission as required by the Federal statutory provisions noted above.

Wherefore, Sprint-Florida, Incorporated respectfully requests that the Florida Public Service Commission approve the Amendment to the Interconnection Agreement between Sprint-Florida and MCIm.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO MCIM/SPRIN'T INTERCONNECTION AGREEMENT DATED APRIL 16, 1997

Pursuant to this Amendment to the MCIm/Sprint Interconnection Agreement (the "Amendment"), for the state of Florida, MCImetro Access Transmission Services, L.L.C. ("MCIm") and Sprint – Florida, Incorporated ("Sprint"), a Florida corporation, collectively referred to as the Parties, agree to amend the MCIm/Sprint Interconnection Agreement dated April 16, 1997 ("Interconnection Agreement").

In consideration of the mutual provisions contained in this agreement and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree and covenant as follows:

- 2.4.1 Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, MCIm is permitted to collocate remote digital line unit ("RDLU") equipment in its collocated space.
