Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and Northpoint Communications, Inc. are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission an amendment to their negotiated agreement for the interconnection of their networks. the unbundling of specific network elements offered by BellSouth and the resale of BellSouth's telecommunications services to Northpoint Communications, Inc. The Commission approved the initial agreement between the companies in Order No. 98-1329-FOF-TP issued October 12, 1998 in Docket 980826-TP: 980865·TP2

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving the negotiated agreement between BellSouth or reiectina and Northpoint Communications, Inc. within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their agreement.

AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN NORTHPOINT COMMUNICATIONS, INC. AND BELLSOUTH TELECOMMUNICATIONS, INC. DATED JUNE 9, 1998

Pursuant to this Agreement, (the "Amendment"), NorthPoint Communications, Inc. ("NorthPoint"), and BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. ("BellSouth"), hereinafter referred to collectively as the "Parties," hereby agree to amend that certain Agreement between the Parties dated June 9, 1998 (Agreement").

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual provisions contained herein and other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties hereby covenant and agree as follows:

1. Attachment 4 (As Amended on October 28, 1999) - The following language is hereby deleted in its entirety:

The rates, terms and conditions contained within this Attachment were negotiated as a whole and each rate, term and condition within the Attachment is interdependent upon the other rates, terms and conditions.

Section 1.1 is amended to include the following:

All the negotiated rates, terms and conditions set forth in this Attachment pertain to collocation and the provisioning of collocation space.

2. Attachment 11 – Rates for the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee (As amended on October 28, 1999) – The following language is hereby deleted in its entirety:

The rates, terms and conditions contained within this Attachment were negotiated as a whole and each rate, term and condition within the Attachment is interdependent upon the other rates, terms and conditions within this Agreement.

3. All of the other provisions of the Agreement, dated June 9, 1998, shall remain in full force and effect.

4. Either or both of the Parties is authorized to submit this Amendment to the respective state regulatory authorities for approval subject to Section 252(e) of the Federal Telecommunications Act of 1996.
