Dear Mrs. Bayo:

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996, BellSouth and EZ Talk Communications are submitting to the Florida Public Service Commission their negotiated agreement for the purchase of BellSouth's telecommunications services for the purpose of resale to end users by EZ Talk Communications.

Pursuant to section 252(e) of the Act, the Commission is charged with approving or rejecting the negotiated agreement between BellSouth and EZ Talk Communications within 90 days of its submission. The Act provides that the Commission may only reject such an agreement if it finds that the agreement or any portion of the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier not a party to the agreement or the implementation of the agreement or any portion of the agreement with the public interest, convenience and necessity. Both parties aver that neither of these reasons exist as to the agreement they have negotiated and therefore, are very hopeful that the Commission shall approve their agreement.

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AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., ("BellSouth"), a Georgia corporation, and EZ Talk Communications, Inc. ("EZ Talk"), a Texas corporation, and shall be deemed effective as of the date of signature by both parties. This Agreement may refer to either BellSouth or EZ Talk or both as a "Party" or "Parties. "

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, BeilSouth is a local exchange telecommunications company authorized to provide telecommunications services in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, EZ Talk is an alternative local exchange telecommunications company ("CLEC") authorized to provide telecommunications services in the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee; and

WHEREAS, the Parties wish to resell BellSouth's telecommunications services and/or interconnect their facilities, purchase network elements and other services, and exchange traffic specifically for the purposes of fulfilling their obligations pursuant to sections 251 and 252 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("the Act").

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual agreements contained herein. BellSouth and EZ Talk agree as follows:

1. <u>Purpose</u>

The Parties agree that the rates, terms and conditions contained within this Agreement, including all Attachments, comply and conform with each Parties' obligations under sections 251 and 252 of the Act. The resale, access and interconnection obligations contained herein enable EZ Talk to provide competing telephone exchange service to residential and business subscribers within the territory of BellSouth. The Parties agree that EZ Talk will not be considered to have offered telecommunications services to the public in any state within BellSouth's region until such time as it has ordered services for resale or interconnection facilities for the purposes of providing business and/or residential local exchange service to customers.

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2. <u>Term of the Agreement</u>

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- 2.1 The term of this Agreement shall be two years, beginning at the date of signature by both parties and shall apply to the states of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee. If as of the expiration of this Agreement, a Subsequent Agreement (as defined in Section 2.2 below) has not been executed by the Parties, this Agreement shall continue on a month-to-month basis while a Subsequent Agreement is being negotiated. The Parties' rights and obligations with respect to this Agreement after expiration shall be as set forth in Section 2.4 below.
- 2.2 The Parties agree that by no later than one hundred and eighty (180) days prior to the expiration of this Agreement, they shall commence negotiations with regard to the terms, conditions and prices of resale and/or local interconnection to be effective beginning on the expiration date of this Agreement ("Subsequent Agreement").
- 2.3 If, within one hundred and thirty-five (135) days of commencing the negotiation referred to in Section 2.2, above, the Parties are unable to satisfactorily negotiate new resale and/or local interconnection terms, conditions and prices, either Party may petition the Commission to establish appropriate local interconnection and/or resale arrangements pursuant to 47 U.S.C. 252. The Parties agree that, in such event, they shall encourage the Commission to issue its order regarding the appropriate local interconnection and/or resale arrangements no later than the expiration date of this Agreement. The Parties further agree that in the event the Commission does not issue its order prior to the expiration date of this Agreement to negotiate the local interconnection and/or resale arrangements without Commission intervention, the terms, conditions and prices ultimately ordered by the Commission, or negotiated by the Parties, will be effective retroactive to the day following the expiration date of this Agreement.
- 2.4 Notwithstanding the foregoing, in the event that as of the date of expiration of this Agreement and conversion of this Agreement to a month-to-month term, the Parties have not entered into a Subsequent Agreement and either no arbitration proceeding has been filed in accordance with Section 2.3 above, or the Parties have not mutually agreed (where permissible) to extend the arbitration window for petitioning the applicable Commission(s) for resolution of those terms upon which the Parties have not agreed, then either Party may terminate this Agreement upon sixty (60) days notice to the other Party. In the event that BellSouth terminates this Agreement as provided above, BellSouth shall continue to offer services to EZ Talk pursuant to the terms, conditions and rates set forth in BellSouth's Statement of Generally Available Terms (SGAT) to the extent an SGAT has been approved by the applicable Commission(s). If any state Commission has not approved a BellSouth SGAT, then upon BellSouth's termination of this Agreement as provided herein, BellSouth will continue to

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provide services to EZ Talk pursuant to BellSouth's then current standard interconnection agreement. In the event that the SGAT or BellSouth's standard interconnection agreement becomes effective as between the Parties, the Parties may continue to negotiate a Subsequent Agreement, and the terms of such Subsequent Agreement shall be effective retroactive to the day following expiration of this Agreement.

3. Ordering Procedures

- 3.1 EZ Talk shaft provide BellSouth its Carrier Identification Code (CIC). Operating Company Number (OCN), Group Access Code (GAC) and Access Customer Name and Address (ACNA) code as applicable prior to placing its first order.
- 3.2 The Parties agree to adhere to the BellSouth Local Interconnection and Facility Based Ordering Guide and Resale Ordering Guide, as appropriate for the services ordered.
- 3.3 EZ Talk shall pay charges for Operational Support Systems (OSS) as set forth in this Agreement in Attachment 1 and/or in Attachment 2, 3, 5 and 7 as applicable.

4. <u>Parity</u>

When EZ Talk purchases, pursuant to Attachment 1 of this Agreement, telecommunications services from BellSouth for the purposes of resale to end users, BellSouth shall provide said services so that the services are equal in quality, subject to the same conditions, and provided within the same provisioning time intervals that BellSouth provides to its affiliates, subsidiaries and end users. To the extent technically feasible, the quality of a Network Element, as well as the quality of the access to such Network Element provided by BellSouth to EZ Talk shall be at least equal in quality to that which BellSouth provides to itself. The quality of the interconnection between the networks of BellSouth and the network of EZ Talk shall be at a level that is equal to that which BellSouth provides itself, a subsidiary, an Affiliate, or any other party. The interconnection facilities shall be designed to meet the same technical criteria and service standards that are used within BellSouth's network and shall extend to a consideration of service quality as perceived by end users and service quality as perceived by EZ Talk.

5. White Pages Listings

BellSouth shall provide EZ Talk and their customers access to white pages directory listings under the following terms:

5.1 <u>Listings.</u> BellSouth or its agent will include EZ Talk residential and business customer listings in the appropriate White Pages (residential and business) or

alphabetical directories. Directory listings will make no distinction between EZ Talk and BellSouth subscribers.

- 5.2 <u>Rates.</u> Subscriber primary listing information in the White Pages shall be provided at no charge to EZ Talk or its subscribers provided that EZ Talk provides subscriber listing information to BellSouth at no charge.
- 5.3 <u>Procedures for Submitting EZ Talk Subscriber Information</u>. BellSouth will provide to EZ Talk a magnetic tape or computer disk containing the proper format for submitting subscriber listings. EZ Talk will be required to provide BellSouth with directory listings and daily updates to those listings, including new, changed, and deleted listings, in an industry-accepted format. These procedures are detailed in BellSouth's Local Interconnection and Facility Based Ordering Guide.
- 5.4 Unlisted/Non-Published Subscribers. EZ Talk will be required to provide to BellSouth the names, addresses and telephone numbers of all EZ Talk customers that wish to be omitted from directories.
- 5.5 Inclusion of EZ Talk Customers in Directory Assistance Database. BellSouth will include and maintain EZ Talk subscriber listings in BellSouth's directory assistance databases at no charge. BellSouth and EZ Talk will formulate appropriate procedures regarding lead time, timeliness, format and content of listing information.
- 5.6 Listing Information Confidentiality. BellSouth will accord EZ Talk's directory listing information the same level of confidentiality that BellSouth accords its own directory listing information, and BellSouth shall limit access to EZ Talk's customer proprietary confidential directory information to those BellSouth employees who are involved in the preparation of listings.
- 5.7 <u>Optional Listings</u>. Additional listings and optional listings will be offered by BellSouth at tariffed rates as set forth in the General Subscriber Services Tariff.
- 5.8 <u>Delivery</u>. BellSouth or its agent shall deliver White Pages directories to EZ Taik subscribers at no charge.

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6. Bona Fide Request/New Business Request Process for Further Unbundling

If EZ Talk is a facilities based provider or a facilities based and resale provider, this section shall apply. BeliSouth shall, opon request of EZ Talk, provide to EZ Talk access to its incloverk elements at any technically feasible point for the provision of EZ Talk's telecommunications service where such access is necessary and failure to provide access would impair the ability of EZ Talk to provide services that it seeks to offer. Any request by EZ Talk for access to a network element, interconnection option, or for the provisioning of any service or product that is not already available shall be treated as a Bona Fide Request/New Business Request, and shall be submitted to BellSouth pursuant to the Bona Fide Request/New Business Request process set forth following.

6.1 A Bona Fide Request/New Business Request shall be submitted in writing to EZ Talk's Account Manager by EZ Talk and shall specifically identify the requested service date, technical requirements, space requirements and/or such specifications that clearly define the request such that BellSouth has sufficient information to analyze and prepare a response. Such a request also shall include a EZ Talk's designation of the request as being (i) pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 or (ii) pursuant to the needs of the business.

7. <u>Court Ordered Requests for Call Detail Records and Other Subscriber</u> Information.

To the extent technically feasible, BellSouth maintains call detail records for EZ Talk end users for limited time periods and can respond to subpoents and court ordered requests for this information. BellSouth shall maintain such information for EZ Talk end users for the same length of time it maintains such information for its own end users.

- EZ Talk agrees that BellSouth will respond to subpoenas and court ordered requests delivered directly to BellSouth for the purpose of providing call detail records when the targeted telephone numbers belong to EZ Talk end users.
 Billing for such requests will be generated by BellSouth and directed to the law enforcement agency initiating the request.
- 7.2 EZ Talk agrees that in cases where EZ Talk receives subpoenas or court ordered requests for call detail records for targeted telephone numbers belonging to EZ Talk end users, EZ Talk will advise the law enforcement agency initiating the request to redirect the subpoena or court ordered request to BellSouth. Billing for call detail information will be generated by BellSouth and directed to the law enforcement agency initiating the request.

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- 7.3 In cases where the timing of the response to the law enforcement agency prohibits EZ Talk from having the subpoena or court ordered request redirected to BellSouth by the law enforcement agency, EZ Talk will furnish the official request to BellSouth for providing the call detail information. BeilSouth will provide the call detail records to EZ Talk and bill EZ Talk for the information. EZ Talk agrees to reimburse BellSouth for the call detail information provided.
- 7.4 EZ Talk will provide EZ Talk end user and/or other customer information that is available to EZ Talk in response to subpoents and court orders for their own customer records. BellSouth will redirect subpoents and court ordered requests for EZ Talk end user and/or other customer information to EZ Talk for the purpose of providing this information to the law enforcement agency.

8. Liability and Indemnification

- 8.1 BellSouth Liability. BellSouth shall take financial responsibility for its own actions in causing, or its lack of action in preventing, unbillable or uncollectible EZ Talk revenues.
- 8.2 <u>EZ Talk Liability</u>. In the event that EZ Talk consists of two (2) or more separate entities as set forth in the preamble to this Agreement, all such entities shall be jointly and severally liable for the obligations of EZ Talk under this Agreement.
- 8.3 Liability for Acts or Omissions of Third Parties. Neither BellSouth nor EZ Talk shall be liable for any act or omission of another telecommunications company providing a portion of the services provided under this Agreement.
- 8.4 Limitation of Liability.
- 8.4.1 Each Party's liability to the other for any loss, cost, claim, injury or liability or expense, including reasonable attorney's fees relating to or arising out of any negligent act or omission in its performance of this Agreement whether in contract or in tort, shall be limited to a credit for the actual cost of the services or functions not performed or improperly performed.
- 8.4.2 Limitations in Tariffs. A Party may, in its sole discretion, provide in its tariffs and contracts with its Customer and third parties that relate to any service, product or function provided or contemplated under this Agreement, that to the maximum extent permitted by Applicable Law, such Party shall not be liable to Customer or third Party for (i) any Loss relating to or arising out of this Agreement, whether in contract, tort or otherwise, that exceeds the amount such Party would have charged that applicable person for the service, product or function that gave rise to such Loss and (ii) Consequential Damages. To the extent that a Party elects not to place in its tariffs or contracts such limitations of liability, and the other Party incurs a Loss as a result thereof, such Party shall indemnify and reimburse the

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other Party for that portion of the Loss that would have been limited had the first Party included in its tariffs and contracts the limitations of liability that such other Party included in its own tariffs at the time of such Loss.

8.4.3 Neither BellSouth nor EZ Talk shall be liable for damages to the other's terminal location, POI or other company's customers' premises resulting from the furnishing of a service, including, but not limited to, the installation and removal of equipment or associated wiring, except to the extent caused by a company's negligence or willful misconduct or by a company's failure to properly ground a local loop after disconnection.

- 8.4.4 Under no circumstance shall a Party be responsible or liable for indirect, incidental, or consequential damages, including, but not limited to, economic loss or lost business or profits, damages arising from the use or performance of equipment or software, or the loss of use of software or equipment, or accessories attached thereto, delay, error, or loss of data. In connection with this limitation of liability, each Party recognizes that the other Party may, from time to time, provide advice, make recommendations, or supply other analyses related to the Services, or facilities described in this Agreement, and, while each Party shall use diligent efforts in this regard, the Parties acknowledge and agree that this limitation of liability shall apply to provision of such advice, recommendations, and analyses.
- 8.5 Indemnification for Certain Claims. The Party providing services hereonder, its affiliates and its parent company, shall be indemnified, defended and held hatmless by the Party receiving services hereunder against any claim, loss or damage arising from the receiving company's use of the services provided under this Agreement pertaining to (1) claims for libel, slander or invasion of privacy arising from the content of the receiving company's own communications, or (2) any claim, loss or damage claimed by the costomer of the Party receiving services arising from such company's use or reliance on the providing company's services, actions, duties, or obligations arising out of this Agreement.
- 8.6 <u>Disclaimer</u>. EXCEPT AS SPECIFICALLY PROVIDED TO THE CONTRARY IN THIS AGREEMENT, NEITHER PARTY MAKES ANY REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES TO THE OTHER PARTY CONCERNING THE SPECIFIC QUALITY OF ANY SERVICES, OR FACILITIES PROVIDED UNDER THIS AGREEMENT. THE PARTIES DISCLAIM. WITHOUT LIMITATION, ANY WARRANTY OR GUARANTEE OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, ARISING FROM COURSE OF PERFORMANCE, COURSE OF DEALING, OR FROM USAGES OF TRADE.

9. Intellectual Property Rights and Indemnification

- 9.1 <u>No License</u>. No patent, copyright, trademark or other proprietary right is licensed, granted or otherwise transferred by this Agreement. EZ Talk is strictly prohibited from any use, including but not limited to in sales, in marketing or advertising of telecommunications services, of any BellSouth name, service mark or (rademark.
- 9.2 Ownership of Intellectual Property. Any intellectual property which originates tirom or is developed by a Party shall remain in the exclusive ownership of that Party. Except for a limited license to use patents or copyrights to the extent necessary for the Parties to use any facilities or equipment (including software) or to receive any service solely as provided under this Agreement, no license in patent, copyright, trademark or trade secret, or other proprietary or intellectual property right now or hereafter owned, controlled or licensable by a Party, is granted to the other Party or shall be implied or arise by estoppel. It is the responsibility of each Party to ensure at no additional cost to the other Party that it has obtained any necessary licenses in relation to intellectual property of third Parties used in its network that may be required to enable the other Party to use any facilities or equipment (including software), to receive any service, or to perform its respective obligations under this Agreement.
- 9.3 Indomnification. The Party providing a service pursuant to this Agreement will defend the Party receiving such service or data provided as a result of such service against claims of infringement arising solely from the use by the receiving Party of such service and will indemnify the receiving Party for any damages awarded based solely on such claims in accordance with Section 8 of this Agreement.
- 9.4 <u>Claim of Infringement</u>. In the event that use of any facilities or equipment (including software), becomes, or in reasonable judgment of the Party who owns the affected network is likely to become, the subject of a claim, action, suit, or proceeding based on intellectual property infringement, then said Party shall promptly and at its sole expense, but subject to the limitations of liability set forth below:
- 9.4.1 modify or replace the applicable facilities or equipment (including software) while maintaining form and function, or
- 9.4.2 obtain a license sufficient to allow such use to continue.
- 9.4.3 In the event 9.4.1 or 9.4.2 are commercially unreasonable, then said Party may, terminate, upon reasonable notice, this contract with respect to use of, or services provided through use of, the affected facilities or equipment (including software), but solely to the extent required to avoid the infringement claim.
- 9.5 Exception to Obligations. Neither Party's obligations under this Section shall apply to the extent the infringement is caused by: (i) modification of the facilities or equipment (including software) by the indemnitee; (ii) use by the indemnitee of

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the facilities or equipment (including software) in combination with equipment or facilities (including software) not provided or authorized by the indemnitor provided the facilities or equipment (including software) would not be infringing if used alone; (iii) conformance to specifications of the indemnitee which would necessarily result in infringoment; or (iv) continued use by the indemnitee of the affected facilities or equipment (including software) after being placed on notice to discontinue use as set forth herein.

9.6 <u>Exclusive Remedy</u>. The foregoing shall constitute the Parties' sole and exclusive remedies and obligations with respect to a third party claim of intellectual property infringement arising out of the conduct of business under this Agreement.

10. Treatment of Proprietary and Confidential Information

- 10.1 Confidential Information. It may be necessary for BellSouth and EZ Talk to provide each other with certain confidential information, including trade secret information, including but not limited to, technical and business plans, technical information, proposals, specifications, drawings, procedures, customer account data, call detail records and like information (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Information"). All Information shall be in writing or other tangible form and clearly marked with a confidential, private or proprietary legend and that the Information will be returned to the owner within a reasonable time. The Information shall not be copied or reproduced in any form. BellSouth and EZ Talk shall receive such Information and not disclose such Information. BellSouth and EZ Talk shall protect the information received from distribution, disclosure or dissemination to anyone except employees of BellSouth and EZ Talk with a need to know such Information and which employees agree to be bound by the terms of this Section. BeliSouth and EZ Talk will use the same standard of care to protect Information received as they would use to protect their own confidential and proprietary information.
- 10.2 Exception to Obligation. Notwithstanding the foregoing, there will be no obligation on BellSouth or EZ Talk to protect any portion of the Information that is: (1) made publicly available by the owner of the Information or lawfully disclosed by a Party other than BellSouth or E2 Talk; (2) lawfully obtained from any source other than the owner of the Information; or (3) previously known to the receiving Party without an obligation to keep it confidential.

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11. Assignments

Any assignment by either Party to any non-affiliated entity of any right, obligation or duty, or of any other interest hereunder, in whole or in part, without the prior written consent of the other Party shall be void. A Party may assign this Agreement or any right, obligation, duty or other interest hereunder to an Affiliate company of the Party without the consent of the other Party. All obligations and dutics of any Party under this Agreement shall be binding on all successors in interest and assigns of such Party. No assignment or delegation hereof shall relieve the assignor of its obligations under this Agreement in the event that the assignce fails to perform such obligations.

12. <u>Resolution of Disputes</u>

Except as otherwise stated in this Agreement, the Parties agree that if any dispute arises as to the interpretation of any provision of this Agreement or as to the proper implementation of this Agreement, either Party may petition the Commission for a resolution of the dispute. However, each Party reserves any tights it may have to seek judicial review of any ruling made by the Commission concerning this Agreement.

13. <u>Taxes</u>

- 13.1 <u>Definition</u>. For purposes of this Section, the terms "taxes" and "fees" shall include but not limited to federal, state or local sales, use, excise, gross receipts or other taxes or tax-like tees of whatever nature and however designated (including tariff surcharges and any fees, charges or other payments, contractual or otherwise, for the use of public streets or rights of way, whether designated as franchise fees or otherwise) imposed, or sought to be imposed, on or with respect to the services furnished hereunder or measured by the charges or payments therefore, excluding any taxes levied on income.
- 13.2 Taxes and Fees Imposed Directly On Either Providing Party or Purchasing Party.
- Taxes and fees imposed on the providing Party, which are not permitted or required to be passed on by the providing Party to its customer, shall be borne and paid by the providing Party.
- 13.2.2 Taxes and fees imposed on the purchasing Party, which are not required to be collected and/or remitted by the providing Party, shall be home and paid by the purchasing Party.
- 13.3
 Taxes and Fees Imposed on Purchasing Party But Collected And Remitted By Providing Party.

- Taxes and fees imposed on the purchasing Party shall be borne by the purchasing Party, even if the obligation to collect and/or remit such taxes or fees is placed on the providing Party.
- 13.3.2 To the extent permitted by applicable law, any such taxes and/or fees shall be shown as separate items on applicable billing documents between the Parties. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the purchasing Party shall remain liable for any such taxes and fees regardless of whether they are actually billed by the providing Party at the time that the respective service is billed.
- 13.3.3 If the purchasing Party determines that in its opinion any such taxes or fees are not payable, the providing Party shall not bill such taxes or fees to the purchasing Party if the purchasing Party provides written certification, reasonably satisfactory to the providing Party, stating that it is exempt or otherwise not subject to the tax or fee, setting forth the basis therefor, and satisfying any other requirements under applicable law. If any authority seeks to collect any such tax or fee that the purchasing Party has determined and certified not to be payable, or any such tax or fee that was not billed by the providing Party, the purchasing Party may contest the same in good faith, at its own expense. In any such contest, the purchasing Party shall promptly fornish the providing Party with copies of all fillings in any proceeding, protest, or legal challenge, all rulings issued in connection therewith, and all correspondence between the purchasing Party and the taxing authority.
- 13.3.4 In the event that all or any portion of an amount sought to be collected must be paid in order to contest the imposition of any such tax or fee, or to avoid the existence of a lien on the assets of the providing Party during the pendency of such contest, the purchasing Party shall be responsible for such payment and shall be entitled to the benefit of any refund or recovery.
- 13.3.5 If it is ultimately determined that any additional amount of such a tax or fec is due to the imposing authority, the purchasing Party shall pay such additional amount, including any interest and penalties thereon.
- 13.3.6 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the purchasing Party shall protect, indemnify and hold harmless (and defend at the purchasing Party's expense) the providing Party from and against any such tax or life, interest or penalties thereon, or other charges or payable expenses (including reasonable attorney lifes) with respect thereto, which are incurred by the providing Party in connection with any claim for or contest of any such tax or life.
- 13.3.7 Each Party shall notify the other Party in writing of any assessment, proposed assessment or other claim for any additional amount of such a tax or fee by a taxing authority; such notice to be provided, if possible, at least ten (10) days prior to the date by which a response, protest or other appeal must be filed, but in no event later than thirty (30) days after receipt of such assessment, proposed assessment or claim.

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13.4 Taxes and Fees Imposed on Providing Party Bet Passed On To Purchasing Party.

- Taxes and fees imposed on the providing Party, which are permitted or required to be passed on by the providing Party to its customer, shall be borne by the purchasing Party.
- 13.4.2 To the extent permitted by applicable law, any such taxes and/or fees shall be shown as separate items on applicable billing documents between the Parties. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the purchasing Party shall remain liable for any such taxes and lees regardless of whether they are actually billed by the providing Party at the time that the respective service is billed.
- 13.4.3 If the purchasing Party disagrees with the providing Party's determination as to the application or basis for any such tax or fee, the Parties shall consult with respect to the imposition and billing of such tax or fee. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the providing Party shall retain ultimate responsibility for determining whether and to what extent any such taxes or fees are applicable, and the purchasing Party shall abide by such determination and pay such taxes or fees to the providing Party. The providing Party shall further retain ultimate responsibility for determining whether and how to contest the imposition of such taxes and fees; provided, however, that any such contest undertaken at the request of the purchasing Party shall be at the purchasing Party's expense.
- 13.4.4 In the event that all or any portion of an amount sought to be collected must be paid in order to contest the imposition of any such tax or fee, or to avoid the existence of a lien on the assets of the providing Party during the pendency of such contest, the purchasing Party shall be responsible for such payment and shall be entitled to the benefit of any refund or recovery.
- 13.4.5 If it is ultimately determined that any additional amount of such a tax or fee is due to the imposing authority, the purchasing Party shall pay such additional amount, including any interest and penalties thereon.
- 13.4.6 Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the purchasing Party shall protect indemnify and hold harmless (and defend at the purchasing Party's expense) the providing Party from and against any such tax or fee, interest or penalties thereon, or other reasonable charges or payable expenses (including reasonable attorney fccs) with respect thereto, which are incurred by the providing Party in connection with any claim for or contest of any such tax or fcc.
- Each Party shall notify the other Party in writing of any assessment, proposed assessment or other claim for any additional amount of such a tax or fee by a taxing authority; such notice to be provided, if possible, at least ten (10) days prior to the date by which a response, protest or other appeal must be filed, but in

no event later than thirty (30) days after receipt of such assessment, proposed assessment or claim.

13.5 <u>Matual Cooperation</u>. In any contest of a tax or fee by one Party, the other Party shall cooperate fully by providing records, testimony and such additional information or assistance as may reasonably be necessary to pursue the contest. Further, the other Party shall be reimbursed for any reasonable and necessary out-of-pocket copying and travel expenses incurred in assisting in such contest.

14. Force Majeure

In the event performance of this Agreement, or any obligation hereunder, is either directly or indirectly prevented, restricted, or interfered with by reason of fire, flood, earthquake or like acts of God, wars, revolution, civil commotion, explosion, acts of public enemy, embargo, acts of the government in its sovereign capacity, labor difficulties, including without limitation, strikes, slowdowns, picketing, or boycotts, unavailability of equipment from vendor, changes requested by Customer, or any other circumstances beyond the reasonable control and without the fault or negligence of the Party affected, the Party affected, upon giving prompt notice to the other Party, shall be excused from such performance on a day-to-day basis to the extent of such prevention, restriction, or interference (and the other Party shall likewise be excused from performance of its obligations on a day-to-day basis until the delay, restriction or interference has ceased); provided however, that the Party so affected shall use diligent efforts to avoid or remove such causes of non-performance and both Parties shall proceed whenever such causes are removed or cease.

15. Year 2000 Compliance

Each Party warrants that it has implemented a program the goal of which is to ensure that all software, hardware and related materials (collectively called "Systems") delivered, connected with BellSouth or supplied in the furtherance of the terms and conditions specified in this Agreement: (i) will record, store, process and display calendar dates falling on or after January 1, 2000, in the same manner, and with the same functionality as such software records, stores, processes and calendar dates falling on or before December 31, 1999; and (ii) shall include without limitation date data century recognition, calculations that accommodate same century and multicentury formulas and date values, and date data interface values that reflect the century.

16. Modification of Agreement

BellSouth shall make available, pursuant to 47 USC § 252 and the FCC rules and regulations regarding such availability, to EZ Talk any interconnection, service, or network element provided under any other agreement filed and approved pursuant to 47 USC § 252. The Parties shall adopt all rates, terms and conditions concerning.

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such other interconnection, service or network element and any other rates, terms and conditions that are interrelated or were negotiated in exchange for or in conjunction with the interconnection, service or network element being adopted. The adopted interconnection, service, or network element and agreement shall apply to the same states as such other agreement and for the identical term of such other agreement.

- If EZ Talk changes its name or makes changes to its company structure or identity due to a merger, acquisition, transfer or any other reason, it is the responsibility of EZ Talk to notify BellSouth of said change and request that an amendment to this Agreement, if necessary, be executed to reflect said change.
- 16.3 No modification, amendment, supplement to, or waiver of the Agreement or any of its provisions shall be effective and binding upon the Parties unless it is made in writing and duly signed by the Parties.
- 16.4 Execution of this Agreement by either Party does not confirm or infer that the executing Party agrees with any decision(s) issued pursuant to the Telecommunications Act of 1996 and the consequences of those decisions on specific language in this Agreement. Neither Party waives its rights to appeal or otherwise challenge any such decision(s) and each Party reserves all of its rights to pursue any and all legal and/or equilable remedies, including appeals of any such decision(s).
- 16.5 In the event that any final and nonappealable legislative, regulatory, judicial or other legal action materially affects any material terms of this Agreement, or the ability of EZ Talk or BellSouth to perform any material terms of this Agreement, EZ Talk or BellSouth may, on thirty (30) days' written notice require that such terms be renegotiated, and the Parties shall renegotiate in good faith such mutually acceptable new terms as may be required. In the event that such new terms are not renegotiated within ninety (90) days after such notice, the Dispute shall be referred to the Dispute Resolution procedure set forth in Section 12.
- 16.6 If any provision of this Agreement, or the application of such provision to either Party or circumstance, shall be held invalid, the remainder of the Agreement, or the application of any such provision to the Parties or circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid, shall not be effective thereby, provided that the Parties shall attempt to reformulate such invalid provision to give effect to such portions thereof as may be valid without defeating the intent of such provision.

17. <u>Waivers</u>

A failure or delay of either Party to enforce any of the provisions hereof, to exercise any option which is herein provided, or to require performance of any of the provisions hereof shall in no way be construed to be a waiver of such provisions or options, and each Party, notwithstanding such failure, shall have the right thereafter

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to insist upon the specific performance of any and all of the provisions of this. Agreement.

18. <u>Governing Law</u>

This Agreement shall be governed by, and construed and enforced in accordance with, the laws of the State of Georgia, without regard to its conflict of laws principles.

19. Arm's Length Negotiations

This Agreement was executed after arm's length negotiations between the undersigned Parties and reflects the conclusion of the undersigned that this Agreement is in the best interests of all Parties.

20. Notices

20.1 Every notice, consent, approval, or other communications required or contemplated by this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered in person or given by postage prepaid mail, address to:

20.2 Where specifically required, notices shall be by certified or registered mail. Unless otherwise provided in this Agreement, notice by mail shall be effective on the date it is officially recorded as delivered by return receipt or equivalent, and in

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the absence of such record of delivery, it shall be presumed to have been delivered the fifth day, or next business day after the fifth day, after it was deposited in the mails.

20.3 BellSouth shall provide EZ Talk notice via Internet posting of price changes and of changes to the terms and conditions of services available for resale.

21. Rule of Construction

No rule of construction requiring interpretation against the drafting Party hereof shall apply in the interpretation of this Agreement.

22. Headings of No Force or Effect

The headings of Articles and Sections of this Agreement are for convenience of reference only, and shall in no way define, modify or restrict the meaning or interpretation of the terms or provisions of this Agreement.

23. <u>Multiple Counterparts</u>

This Agreement may be executed multiple counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, but all of which shall together constitute hut one and the same document.


24. Implementation of Agreement

If EZ Talk is a facilities based provider or a facilities based and resale provider, this section shall apply. Within 60 days of the execution of this Agreement, the Parties will adopt a schedule for the implementation of the Agreement. The schedule shall state with specificity time frames for submission of including but not limited to, network design, interconnection points, collocation arrangement requests, pre-sales testing and full operational time frames for the business and residential markets. An implementation template to be used for the implementation schedule is contained in Attachment 10 of this Agreement.

25. Filing of Agreement

Upon execution of this Agreement it shall be filed with the appropriate state regulatory agency pursuant to the requirements of Section 252 of the Act. If the regulatory agency imposes any filing or public interest notice fees regarding the filing or approval of the Agreement, EZ Talk shall be responsible for publishing the required notice and the publication and/or notice costs shall be borne by EZ. Talk.

26. Entire Agreement



This Agreement and its Attachments, incorporated herein by this reference, sets forth the entire understanding and supersedes prior Agreements between the Parties relating to the subject matter contained herein and merges all prior discussions between them, and neither Party shall be bound by any definition, condition, provision, representation, warranty, covenant or promise other than as expressly stated in this Agreement or as is contemporaneously or subsequently set forth in writing and executed by a duly authorized officer or representative of the Party to be bound thereby.

Definitions

Affliate is defined as a person that (directly or indirectly) owns or controls, is owned or controlled by, or is under common ownership or control with, another person. For purposes of this paragraph, the term "own" means to own an equity interest (or equivalent thereof) of more than 10 percent.

Centralized Message Distribution System is the Teleordia (formerly BellCore) administered national system, based in Kansas City, Missouri, used to exchange Exchange Message Interface (EMI) formatted data among host companies.

Commission is defined as the appropriate regulatory agency in each of BellSouth's nine state region. Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Catolina, South Catolina, and Tennessee.

Daily Usage File is the compilation of messages or copies of messages in standard Exchange Message Interface (EMI) format exchanged from BellSouth to an CLEC.

Exchange Message Interface is the nationally administered standard format for the exchange of data among the Exchange Carriers within the telecommunications industry.

Information Service means the offering of a capability for generating, acquiring, storing, transforming, processing, retrieving, utilizing, or making available information via telecommunications, and includes electronic publishing, but does not include any use of any such capability for the management, control, or operation of a telecommunications system or the management of a telecommunications service.

Intercompany Settlements (ICS) is the revenue associated with charges billed by a company other than the company in whose service area such charges were incurred. ICS on a national level includes third number and credit card calls and is administered by Teleordia (formerly BellCore)'s Calling Card and Third Number Settlement System (CATS). Included is traffic that originates in one Regional Bell Operating Company's (RBOC) territory and bills in another RBOC's territory.

Intermediary function is defined as the delivery of traffic from EZ Talk; a CLEC other than EZ Talk or another telecommunications carrier through the network of BellSouth or EZ Talk to an end user of EZ Talk; a CLEC other than EZ Talk or another telecommunications carrier.

Local Interconnection is defined as 1) the delivery of local traffic to be terminated on each Party's local network so that end users of either Party have the ability to reach end users of the other Party without the use of any access code or substantial delay in the processing of the call: 2) the LEC network features, functions, and capabilities set forth in this Agreement; and 3) Service Provider Number Portability sometimes referred to as temporary telephone number portability to be implemented pursuant to the terms of this Agreement. Local Traffic is defined as any telephone call that originates in one exchange and terminates in either the same exchange, or other local calling area associated with the originating exchange as defined and specified in Section A3 of BellSouth's General Subscriber Service Tariff. As clarification of this definition and for reciprocal compensation, Local Traffic does not include waffic that originates from or terminates to or through an enhanced service provider or information service provider. As further clarification, Local Traffic does not include calls that do not wansmit information of the user's choosing. In any event, neither Party will pay reciprocal compensation to the other if the "traffic" to which such reciprocal compensation would otherwise apply was generated, in whole or in part, for the purpose of creating an obligation on the part of the originating carrier to pay reciprocal compensation for such traffic.

Message Distribution is routing determination and subsequent delivery of message data from one company to another. Also included is the interface function with CMDS, where appropriate.

Multiple Exchange Carrier Access Billing ("MECAB") means the document prepared by the Billing Committee of the Ordering and Billing Forum ("OBF:), which functions under the auspices of the Carrier Liaison Committee of the Alliance for Telecommunications Industry Solutions ("ATIS") and by Teleordia (formerly BellCore) as Special Report SR-BDS-000983, Containing the recommended guidelines for the billing of Exchange Service access provided by two or more LECs and/or CLECs or by one LEC in two or more states within a single LATA.

Network Element is defined to mean a facility or equipment used in the provision of a telecommunications service. Such term may include, but is not limited to, features, functions, and capabilities that are provided by means of such facility or equipment, including but not limited to, subscriber numbers, databases, signaling systems, and information sufficient for billing and collection or used in the transmission, routing, or other provision of a telecommunications service. BellSouth offers access to the Network Elements, unbundled loops; network interface device; sub-loop elements; local switching; transport; tandem switching; operator systems; signaling; access to call-related databases; dark fiber as set forth in Attachment 2 of dus Agreement.

Non-Intercompany Settlement System (NICS) is the Teleordia (formerly BellCore) system that calculates non-intercompany settlements amounts due from one company to another within the same RBOC region. It includes credit card, third number and collect messages.

Percent of Interstate Usage (PIU) is defined as a factor to be applied to terminating access services minutes of use to obtain those minutes that should be rated as interstate access services minutes of use. The numerator includes all interstate "non-intermediary" minutes of use, including interstate minutes of use that are forwarded due to service provider number portability less any interstate minutes of use for Terminating Party Pays services, such as 800 Services. The denominator includes all "non-intermediary", local, interstate, intrastate, toll and access minutes of use adjusted for service provider number portability less all minutes attributable to terminating Party pays services.

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Percent Local Usage (PLU) is defined as a factor to be applied to intrastate terminating minutes of use. The numerator shall include all "non-intermediary" local minutes of use adjusted for those minutes of use that only apply local due to Service Provider Number Portability. The denominator is the total intrastate minutes of use including local, intrastate toil, and access, adjusted for Service Provider Number Portability less intrastate terminating Party pays minutes of use.

Revenue Accounting Office (RAO) Status Company is a local exchange company/alternate local exchange company that has been assigned a unique RAO code. Message data exchanged among RAO status companies is grouped (i.e. packed) according to From/To/Bill RAO combinations.

Service Control Points ("SCPs") are defined as databases that store information and have the ability to manipulate data required to offer particular services.

Signal Transfer Points ("STPs") are signaling message switches that interconnect Signaling Links to route signaling messages between switches and databases. STPs enable the exchange of Signaling System 7 ("SS7") messages between switching elements, database elements and STPs. STPs provide access to various BellSouth and third party network elements such as local switching and databases.

Signaling links are dedicated transmission paths carrying signaling messages between carrier switches and signaling networks. Signal Link Transport is a set of two or four dedicated 56 kbps transmission paths between EZ Talk designated Signaling . oints of Interconnection that provide a diverse transmission path and cross connect to a BellSouth Signal Transfer Point.

Telecommunications means the transmission, between or among points specified by the user, of information of the user's choosing, without change in the form or content of the information as sent and received.

Telecommunications Service means the offering of telecommunications for a fee directly to the public, or to such classes of users as to be effectively available directly to the public, regardless of the facilities used.

Telecommunications Act of 1996 ("Act") means Public Law 104-104 of the United States Congress effective February 8, 1996. The Act amended the Communications Act of 1934 (47, U.S.C. Section 1 et. seq.).

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RESALE

Discount Rates

The rates pursuant by which EZ TALK is to purchase services from BellSouth for resale shall be at a discount rate off of the retail rate for the telecommunications service. The discount rates shall be as set forth in Exhibit A, attached here is and incorporated here is by this toference. Such discount shall reflect the costs avoided by BellSouth when selling a service for whilesale purposes.

2. Definition of Terms

- 2.1 CUSTOMER OF RECORD means the entity responsible for placing application for service; requesting additions, rearrangements, maintenance or discontinuance of service: payment in full of charges incurred such as non-recurring, monthly recurring, tolk, directory assistance, etc.
- 2.2 DEPOSIT means assurance provided by a customer in the form of cash, surgry head or bank letter of credit to be held by BellSouth.
- 2.3 END USER means the ultimate user of the felecomentionications services.
- 2.4 END USER CUSTOMER LOCATION means the physical location of the premises where an enduser makes use of the telecommunications services.
- 2.5 NEW SERVICES means functions, features or capabilities that are not currently offered by BellSouth. This includes packaging of existing services or combining a new function, feature or capability with an existing service.
- 2.6 OTHER/COMPETITIVE LOCAL EXCHANGE COMPANY (OLDC/CLEC) means a telephone company certificated by the public service commissions of BellSouth's franchised area to provide local exchange service within BellSouth's franchised area.
- 2.7 RESALE means an activity wherein a certificated CLEC, such as EZTALK subscribes to the telecommunications services of BellSouth and then reoffers those telecommunications services to the public (with or without 'adding value').
- 2.8 RESALE SERVICE AREA means the area, as defined in a public service commission approved certificate of operation, within which an CLEC, such as EZ TALK, may offer resold local exchange telecommunications service.

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3. General Provisions

3.1 EZ TAUK may resell the tariffed local exchange and toll telecommunications services of BollSouth contained in the General Subscriber Service Tariff and Private Line Service Tariff subject to the terms, and conditions specifically set forth neterin. Norwithstanding the foregoing, the exclusions and finitations on services available for resale will be as set forth in Exhibit B, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

All of the negotiated rates, terms and conditions set forth in this Attachment pertain to the resule of BellSouth's retail telecommunications services and often services specified in this Attachment BellSouth's healt make available telecommunications services for recale at the rates set forth in Exhibit A to this Agreement and subject to the exclusions and limitations set forth in Exhibit B to this Agreement. BellSouth does not however write its rights to appeal or otherwise challenge any decision regarding resule that resulted in the discourt rates contained in Exhibit A or the exclusions and limitations contained in Exhibit B. BellSouth (secrices the right to pursue any and all legal and/or equilable remedies, including appeals of any decisions. If such appeals or challenges result in changes in the discount rates or exclusions and limitations, the parties agree that appropriate modifications to this Agreement will be made promptity to make its terms consistent with the outcome of the appeal.

- 3.2 EZ TALK may purchase resale services from BellSouth for their own use in operating their business. The resale discount will apply to those services under the following conditions:
 - 3.2.1 EZ TALK must resell services to other end users
 - 3.2.2 EZ TALK must order services through resale interfaces, i. c., the local Carrier Service Center (ECSC) and/or appropriate Resale Account Teams pursuall to Section 3 of the General Terms and Conditions.
 - 3.2.3 EZ TALK cannot be an alternative local exchange telecommunications company for the single purpose of selling to themselves.
- 3.3 The provision of services by BellSouth to EZ TALK flogs out constitute a joint undertaking for the furnishing of any service.
- 3.4 EZ TALK will be the eastomer of record for all services purchased from BellSouth Except as specified herein, BellSouth will take orders from, bill and expect payment from EZ TALK for all services.
- 3.5 BZ TALK will be BellSouth's single point of contact for all services parchased parsuant to this Agreement. BellSouth shall have no contact with the encluser except to the extent provided for herein.
- 3.0 BeliSouth will continue to bill the end user for any services that the end user specifies it wishes to receive directly from BeliSouth.
- 5.7 BellSouth maintains the right to serve directly any end user within the service area of EZ TALK. BellSouth will continue to directly market its own telecommunications, products and services and in doing so may establish independent relationships with end users of EZ TALK.
- 3.8 Neither Party shall interfere with the right of any person or entity to obtain service directly from the other Zarty.

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- 3.9 Current 6 lephone numbers may normally be retained by the end user. However, telephone numbers are the property of BellSouth and are assigned to the service furnished. EZ_CALK has in projectly right to flie telephone number of any other coll number designation associated with services furnished by BellSouth, and no right to the continuance of service through any particular control office. BellSouth reserves the right to thange such numbers, or the central office designation associated with such numbers, or both, whenever BellSouth deeres a necessary to do so in the conduct of its business.
- 3.10 For the purpose of the result of BollSouth's telecommunications services by EZ TALK, BellSouth will provide EZ TALK with an on-line access to telephone numbers for reservation on a first come first serve basis. Such reservations of telephone numbers, on a pre-ordering basis shall be for a period of nine (9) days. EZ TALK seknowledges that there may be instances where there is a shortage of telephone numbers in a particular Common Language Location Identifier Crale (CLLIC) and in such instances BellSouth may request that EZ TALK cancel its reservations of authors. EZ TALK such comply with such request.

Further, upon EZ TALK's request, and for the purpose of the resale of BellSouth's telecommunications services by EZ TALK. BellSouth will reserve up to 100 telephone numbers per CLLIC, for EZ TALK's sole use. Such telephone number reservations shall be valid for ninety 190) days from the reservation date. EZ TALK acknowledges that there may be instances where there is a shortage of telephone numbers in a particular CULIC and in such instances. BellSouth shall use its best efforts to reserve for a ninety (90) day period a sufficient quantity of EZ TALK's reasonable need in that particular CULIC.

- 3.11 BeltSouth may provide any service or tability for which a charge is not established hereial as long as it is offered on the same terms to EZ_FALK.
- 5.12 Service is furnished subject to the condition that it will not be used for any unlawful purpose.
- 3.13 Service will be discontinued if any law enforcement agency advizes that the service being used is in violation of the law.
- 3.14 BellSouth can refuse service when it has grounds to believe that service will be used in violation of the law.
- 3.15 BellSouth accepts no responsibility to any person for any unlawful not committed by EZ TALK or its end users as part of providing service to EZ TALK for purposes of essale or otherwise.
- 3.16 BellSouth will cooperate fully with law enforcement agencies with subpoeras and court orders for assistance with BellSouth's end users. Law enforcement agency subpoeras and court orders regarding end users of EZ TALK will be directed to EZ TALK. BellSouth will bull EZ TALK for implementing any requests by law enforcement agencies regarding EZ TALK end users.
- 3.17 The characteristics and methods of operation of any circuits, facilities or equipment provided by any person or entity other than BeilSouth shall not:
 - 3.17.1 Interfere with or impair service over any facilities of BellSouth, its affiliates, or its connecting and concurring canneck involved in its service;
 - 3.17.2 Cause damage to BellSouth's plant:
 - 3.17.3 Deepair the privacy of any communications; or
 - 3.17.4 Create bazards to any BellSouth employees or the public

- 3.18 EX/TALK assumes the responsibility of notifying BellSouth regarding less than standard operations with respect to services provided by EZ/TALK.
- 3.19 Facilities and/or equipment utilized by BellSouth to provide service to FZ TALK remain the property of BellSouth.
- White page directory listings will be provided in accordance with regulations set (orthu: Section A6 of the General Subscriber Services Tariff and will be available for resale.
- V21 BollSouth provides electronic access to customer record information. Access is provided through the Local Exchange Navigation System (LENS) and the Telecommunications Access Gareway (TAG). Customer Record Enformation includes but is not himseld to, customer specific information in CRIS and RSAG. In addition, EZ Task shall provide to BellSOuth access to customer record information including electronic access where available. Otherwise, EZ Task shall provide paper copies of customer record information within a teasonable period of time upon request by BellSouth. Customer Record Information is equivalent to but not limited to the type of customer specific information contained in CRIS and RSAG. The Parties agree not to view, copy, or otherwise obtain access to the customer record information of any customer without that customer's periods on the customer record information of any customer without that customer record information only in strict compliance with applicable laws, rules, or regulations of the State in which the service is provided.
- 3.22 All costs incurred by BellSouth to develop and implement operational interfaces shall be recovered from Resellers who utilize the services. Charges for use of Operational Support Systems (OSS) shall be as set forth in Exhibit A of this attachment.
- 3.23 Where available to BellSouth's end users, BellSouth shall provide the following felecommunications services at a discount to allow for voice mail services:
 - Sumplified Message Desk Interface Enhanced ("SMDI-E");
 - Sumplified Message Desk Interface ("SMDI") Message Waiting Indicator ("MWI") stutter dialtone and message waiting light feature capabilities
 - Call Forward on Busy/Don't Answer ("CF-B/DA")
 - Call Forward on Busy ("CF/B").
 - Call Forward Don't Answer ("CP/DA").

Further, BellSouth messaging services set form in BellSouth's Messaging Service Information. Package shall be made available for resale without the wholesale discount

- 3.24 BellSouth's Inside Wire Maintenance Service. Plans may be made available for resole at rates, terms and condutions as set forth by BellSouth and without the wholesale discount
- 3.25 All costs incurred by BellSouth for providing services requested by BZ TALK that are not covered in the BellSouth tariffs shall be recovered from the EZ TALK(s) who utilize those services.
- 3.26 Recovery of charges associated with implementing Number Portability through monthly charges associated with implementing Number Portability through monthly charges associated to end users has been notherized by the FCC. This end user line charge will be billed to Resellers of BellSouth's telecommunications services and will be as filed in FCC No. 1. This charge will not be discounted.

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BellSouth's Provision of Services to EZ TALK

- 4.1 EZ TALK agrees that its resale of BellSouth services shall be as follows:
 - 4.1.1 The result of telecommunications services shall be limited to users and axes conforming to the class of service restrictions.

 - 4.1.3 BellSouth reserves the right to periodically andit services purchased by EZ TALK to establish anthenticity of use. Such and it shall not occur more than once in a calendar year. EZ TALK shall make any accla0 records and data available to BellSouth on BellSouth's auditors on a reasonable basis. BellSouth shall bear the cost of said audit.
- 4.2 Resold services can only be used in the same manner as specified in BeilSouth's Tariffs. Resold services are subject to the same terms and chadditions as are specified for such services when furnished to an individual end user of BellSouth in the appropriate section of BellSouth's Tariffs. Specific tariff features, e.g. a usage allowance per month, shall not be aggregated across multiple texold services.
- 4.7 EZ TALK may resell services only within the specific resale service area as defined in its certificate.
- 4.4 Telephone numbers transmitted via any result service feature are intended solely for the use of the end user of the teature. Result of this information is prohibited.

5. Maintenance of Services

- 5.1 57. TALK will adopt and adhere to the standards contained in the applicable CLEC Work Conter-Operational Understanding Agreement regarding maintenance and installation of service.
- 5.2 Services result under BellSouth's Tsriffs and facilines and equipment provided by BellSouth shall be maintained by BellSouth.
- 5.3 EZ TALK or its coll users may not rearrange, move, disconnect, remove or attempt to repair any facilities owned by BellSouth, other than by connection or disconnection to any interface means used, except with the written consent of BellSouth.
- 5.4 EZ TALK accepts responsibility to notify BellSouth of situations that arise that may result in a service problem.
- 5.5 EZ TALK will be BellSouth's single point of contact for all topair calls on behalf of EZ TALK's end users. The parties agree to provide one another with toll-free contact numbers for such purposes.

- 5.9 BellSouth reserves the right to contact EZ TALK's end users, if deemed necessary, for maintenance purposes.

- 6.1After receiving certification as a local exchange company from the appropriate regulatory agency, EZ TALK will provide the appropriate BellSouth service center the necessary documentation to stuble BeRSouth to establish a master accound for EZ TALK's resold services. Such documentation shall include the Application for Master Account, proof of authority to provide icleontuminications services, an Operating Company Number ("OCN") assigned by the National Exchange Carriers Association ("NECA") and a tax exemption comficate, if applicable. When necessary deposit requirements are met. BellSouth will begin taking orders for the resale of senvice.
- Service orders will be in a standard format designated by BellSouth. 6.2.
- 63 When notification is seceived from EZ TALK that a current and user of BellSouth will subscribe to EZ TALK's service, standard service order intervals for the appropriate class of service will apply.

- 6.5 EZ TALK will be the single point of contact with BellSouth for all subsequent ordering activity. resulting in additions or changes to resold services except that BellSouth will accept a request. directly from the end user for conversion of the and aser's service from EZ TATK to BellSouth on will accept a request from another CLFC for conversion of the end user's service from EZ TALK. to the other LEC. BellSouth will notify EZ TAEK that such a request has been precessed.
- If BellSouth determines that an unauthorized change in local service to EZ TALK has occurred. 6.6 BellSouth will reestablish service with the appropriate local service provider and will assess BZ TALK as the CLEC initiating the unsuthorized change, the enauthorized change charge dearer bed in F.C.C. Tariff No. 1. Section 13 or applicable state raniff. Appropriate nonrecorning charges, as set forth in Section A4, of the General Subsonber Service Tartif, will also be assessed to EZ. TATK. - 6.7.4 The fact that a security deposit has been made in no way relieves EZ TALK from complying with BellSouth's regulations as to advance payments and the prompt payment of bills on presentation ner does it constitute a waiver or modification of the regular practices of BellSouth providing for the discontinuance of service for non-payment of any sums the BellSouth.
- 6.7.5 BellSouth reserves the right to increase the scenarity depoint requirements when, in its sole judgment, circumstances so warrant and/or gross monthly billing has increased beyond the level initially used to determine the scenarity deposit.
- 6.7.6 In the event that EZ TALK defaults on its account, service to EZ TALK will be transmitted and any security deposits held will be applied to its account.
- 6.7.7 Interest on a security deposit shall accrue and be paid in accordance with the terms in the appropriate BellSouth tariff

7. Payment And Billing Arrangements

- 7.1 Prior to submitting orders to BellSouth for local service, a master account must be established for EZ TALK. The EZ TALK is required to provide the following before a master account is established, proof of PSC/PUC certification, the Application for Master Account, an Operating Company Number ("OCN") assigned by the National Exchange Carriers Association ("NECA") and a tax exemption certificate, if applicable.
- 3.2 BellSouth shall bill EZ TALK on a current basis all applicable charges and credits.
- 7.3 Payment of all charges will be the responsibility of EZ TALK. EZ TALK shall make payment to HellSouth for all services billed. BellSouth is not responsible for payments not received by EZ TALK from EZ TALK's end user. BellSouth will not become involved in billing disputes that may arise between EZ TALK and its end user. Payments made to BellSouth as payment on account will be credited to an account's receivable master account and not to an end user's account.
- 7.4 BollSouth will render bills each month on established bill days for each of EZ TALK's accounts.
- 2 BetlSouth will bill EZ TALK in advance charges for all services to be provided during the ensuing billing period except charges associated with service usage, which will be hilled in artears. Charges will be calculated on an individual enduser account level, including, if applicable, any charge for esage or usage allowances. BellSouth will also bill EZ TALK, and EZ TALK will be responsible for and rentit to BellSouth, all charges applicable to resold services including but not limited to 911 and E911 charges, talecommunications relay charges (TRS), and Sanchise fees
- 7 0 The payment will be due by the next bill date (i.e., same date in the following month as the hill date and is payable in immediately available funds. Payment is considered to have been made when received by BellSouth.
 - 7.6.1 If the payment due date talls on a Sunday or on a Holiday which is observed on a Monday, the payment due date shall be the first non-Holiday day following such Sunday or Holiday. If the payment due date falls on a Satorday or on a Holiday which is observed on Tuesday. Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday, the payment due date shall be

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the last non-Holiday day proceeding such Securitay or Holiday. If payment is not received by the payment due date, a late payment penalty, as set forth in section 7.8 tollowing, shall apply

- 7.6.2 If EZ TALX requests multiple billing media or additional copies of bills. BollSouth will provide these at an appropriate charge to EZ TALK
- 7.6.3 Billing Disputes
 - 3.6.5. Each Party agrees to unitfy the other Party open the discovery of a billing dispute. In the event of a billing dispute, the Parties will endeaver to resolve the dispute within sixty (60) calenday days of the Bill Date on which such dispute charges appear. Resolution of the dispute is expected to occur at the first level of management resulting in a recommendation for settlement of the dispute and closure of a specific billing period. If the issues are not resolved within the afforded time frame, the following resolution procedure will begin:
 - 7.6.3.2 Eithe dispute is not resolved within sixty (60) days of the Bill Date, the dispute will be escalated to the second level of management for each of the respective Parties for resolution. If the dispute is not resolved within ninery (90) days of the Bill Date, the dispute will be escalated to the third level of management for each of the respective Parties for resolution.
 - 7.6.3.3 If the dispute is not resolved within one hundred and twenty (120) days of the Bill Date, the dispute will be escalated to the fourth level of management for each of the respective Parties for resolution.
 - 7.6.3.4 If a Party disputes a charge and does not pay such charge by the payment doe date, such charges shall be subject to late payment charges as set forth in the Late Payment Charges provision of this Attachment. If a Party disputes charges and the dispute is resolved in favor of such Party, the other Party shall credit the bill of the disputing Party for the amount of the disputed charges along with any late payment charges assessed no later than the second Bill Date after the resolution of the dispute. - 7.8 If any portion of the payment is received by BellSouth after the payment due date as set forth preteding, or if any portion of the payment is received by BellSouth in funds that are not interediately available to BellSouth, then a late payment penalty shall be due to BellSouth. The late payment penalty shall be the pontion of the payment not received by the payment due date times a late factor and will be applied on a per bill basis. The late factor shall be as set forth in Section A2 of the General Subscriber Services Tariff and Section B2 of the Private Line Service Tariff. EZ Talk will be charged a fee for all remined obecks as set forth in Section A2 of the General Subscriber Services Tariff or in applicable state law.

- 7.9 Any switched access charges associated with interexchange carrier access to the resold local exchange lines will be billed by, and due to. BellSouth. No additional charges are to be assessed to EZ TALK
- 7.10 BellSouth will not perform billing and collection services for EZ TALK as a result of the execution of this Agreement. All requests for billing services should be referred to the appropriate entity or operational group within BellSouth.
- 7.11 Personn to 47 CFR Section 51.617, BellSouth will bill BZ TALK end user common line charges ulcontext to the 266 astronomous line charges BeilSouth bills its end users.
- 7.12 in general. BellSouth will not become involved in disputes between 62 TALK and 12 TALK's end user customers over resold services. If a dispute does arise that cannot be settled without the involvement of BellSouth, EZ TALK shall contact the designated Service Center for resolution. BellSouth will make every effort to assist in the resolution of the dispute and will work with U2 TALK to resolve the matter in as anely a manner as possible. EZ TALK may be required to submit documentation to substantiate the estim.

8. Discontinuance of Service

- 8.1 The procedures for discontinuing service to an end user are as follows:
 - 8.1.1 Where possible, BellSouth will deny service to EZ TALK's end user on behalf of, and at the request of, EZ TALK. Upon restoration of the end user's service, restoral charges will apply and will be the responsibility of TZ TALK.
 - 8.1.2 At the request of EZ TALK, BellSouth will disconnect a EZ TALK and user customer.
 - 8.1.5 All requests by EZ TALK for denial or disconnection of an end user for nonpayment must be in writing.
 - 8.1.4 EZ TALK will be made solely responsible for notifying the end user of the proposed disconnection of the service.
 - § 1.5 BellSouth will continue to process calls made to the Annoyance Call Center and will advise EZ TALK when it is determined that annoyance calls are originated from one of their enduser's locations. BellSouth shall be indemnified, defended and held harmless by EZ TALK and/or the end user against any claim, loss or damage arising from providing this information to EZ TALK. It is the responsibility of EZ TALK to take the corrective action necessary with its end users who make annoying calls. Failure to do so will result in BellSouth's disconnecting the end user's service.
 - b 1.6 BellSouth may disconnect and reuse facilities when the facility is in a denied state and BellSouth has received an order to establish new service or mansfer of service from an end user for an end user's CLEC at the same address served by the denied facility
- 8.2 The procedures for discontinuing service to BZ TALK are as follows:
 - 8.2.1 BeilSouth reserves the right to suspend or terminate service for nonpayment, excluding amounts which are the subject of bona tide disputes as described in 8.2.3, or in the event of prohibited, unlawful or improper use of the facilities or service, abuse of the facilities, or any other violation or noncompliance by EZ TALK of the rules and regulations of BeilSouth's Tauffs.

- 9.2.2 It payment of secount, excluding amounts which are the subject of bona fide disputes as described in 8.2.3, is not received by the off day in the month after the original bill day. BellSouth may provide written conce to EZ TAUK, that additional applications for service will be refused and that any pending orders for service will not be completed if payment, excluding amounts which are the subject of bona fide disputes as described in 8.2.3, is not received by the fifteenth day following the date of the notice. In addition, BellSouth may, at the same time, give theny days notice to the person designated by TZ TAUK to receive notices of noncompliance, and discontinue the provision of existing services to EZ TAUK at any time thereafter.
- For purposes of this Section 8.2, Bona Fide Dispute means a dispute of a specific amount of money actually billed by BellSouth. The dispute must be clearly explained by EZ Talk and supported by written documentation from EZ Talk, which 8.2.3 clearly shows the basis for EZ Talk's dispute of the charges. The dispute must be itemized to show the Q account and earning number against which the disputed amount applies. By way of example and not by limitation, a sona Fide Dispute will not include the refusal to pay all or part of a bill or bills when no written documentation is provided to support the dispute, nor shall a Bona Fide Dispute include the refusal to pay other amounts owed by the talk until the dispute is resolved. Claims by EZ Talk for damages of any kind will not be considered a Bona Fide Dispute for purposes of this Section 8.2. Once the Bona Fide Dispute is resolved by BST, EZ Talk will make immediate payment on any of the disputed amount owed to BST or BST shall have the right to pursue normal treatment procedures. Any credits due to EZ Talk, pursuant to the Bona Fide pispute, will be applied to the EZ Talk's account by BS1. immediately upon resolution of the dispute.
- 8.2.4 In the case of such discontinuance, all billed charges, as well as applicable termination charges, shall become due.
- 8.2.5 If BellSouth does not discontinue the provision of the services involved on the date specified in the thirty days notice and EZ TALK's noncompliance continues, nothing contained herein shall preclude BellSouth's right to discontinue the provision of the services to EZ TALK without further notice.
- 8.2.6 If payment is not received or arrangements made for payment by the date given in the written notification, EZ TALK's services will be discontinued. Upon discontinuance of service on a EZ TALK's account, service to EZ TALK's end users will be denied. BeBSouth will also reestablish service at the request of the end user or EZ TALK upon payment of the appropriate connection fee and subject to BellSouth's normal application procedures. EZ TALK is only responsible for actifying the end user of the proposed disconnection of the service.
- 8.2.7 If within feffeen days after an end user's service has been denied no contact has been made in reference to restoring service, the end user's service will be disconnected. If EZ-TALK issues a disconnect on its end user's account within the fifteen (15) day period, services will not be hilled for the suspension period.

LINE INFORMATION DATA BASE (LIDB) STORAGE AGREEMENT

L SCOPE

A. This Agreement sets forth the terms and conditions pursuant to which BST agrees to store in its HDB certain information at the request of the Local Exchange Company and pursuant to which (IST, its LIDB customers and Local Exchange Corrier shall have access to such information. Local Exchange Carner understands that BST provides access to information in its HDB to various telecommunications service providers pursuant to applicable tartify and agrees that information stored at the request of Local Exchange Corrier, pursuant to this Agreement, shall be available to those telecommunications service providers. The terms and conditions contained in the attached Addendum(s) are hereby made a part of flux Agreement as if fally incorporated herein.

- B LIDB is accessed for the following purposes:
 - Böled Nomber Screening.
 - Calling Card Validation.
 - 3. Fraud Control

C. HST will provide seven days per week, 24-hours per day, fraud monitoring on Calling Cards, bill-to-third and collect calls made to numbers in BST's LIDB, provided that such information is included in the LIDB query. BST will establish fraud alert thresholds and will notify the Local Exchange Company of fraud alerts so that the Local Exchange Company may take action it deems appropriate. Local Exchange Company inderstands and agrees BST will administer all data stored in the LIDB, including the data provided by Local Exchange Company pursuant to this Agreement, in the same manner is BST's data for BST's end user customers. BST shall not be responsible to Local Exchange Company for any lost revenue which may result from BST's administration of the LIDB pursuant to its established practices and procedures as they exist and as they may be changed by BST in its sole discretion from time to time.

Local Exchange Company understands that BST currently has in effect numerous billing and collection

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agreements with various interexchange carriers and billing clearing houses. Local Exchange Company further understands that fluxe billing and collection customers of BST query BST's LIDB to determine whether to accept various billing options from end users. Additionally, Local Exchange Company understands that presently BST has no method to differentiate between BST's own billing and line data in the LIDF and such data when it includes in the LIDB on Local Exchange Company's behalf pursuant to this Agreement. Therefore, until such time as BST can and does implement in its LIDB and its supporting systems the means to differentiate Local Exchange Company's data from BST's data and the parties to this Agreement execute oppropriate amendments hereto, the following terms and conditions shall apply.

(a) The Local Exchange Company agrees that it will accept responsibility for telecommenications services billed by BST for its billing and collection customers for Local Exchange Unstantic's end user accounts which are resident in LIDB parametric this Agreement. Local Exchange Company pathorizes 3551 to place such charges on Local Exchange Company's bill from BST and agrees that it shall pay all such charges. Charges for which Local Exchange Company hereby takes responsibility include, but are not limited to, collect and third number calls.

(b) Charges for such services shall appear on a separate BST bill page identified with the name of the entity for which BST is billing the charge.

(c) Local Exchange Company shall have the responsibility to render a billing statement to us confusers for these charges, but Local Exchange Company's obligation to pay B51 for the charges hilled shall be independent of whether Local Exchange Company is able or not to collect from the Local Exchange Company's end users.

> ¹ (d) BST shall not become involved in any disputes between Local Exchange Company and the entities for which BST performs billing and collection. BellSouth will not usue adjustments for charges billed on behalf of an entity to Local Exchange Company. It shall be the responsibility of the Local Exchange Company and the other entity to negociate and arrange for any appropriate adjustments.

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II. TERM

This Agreement will be effective as of ______, 199___, and will continue in effect for one year, and thereacter may be continued until terminated by either party upon thirty (36) days written notice to the other party.

III. FEES FOR SERVICE AND TAXES

A. The Local Exchange Company will not be charged a fee for storage services provided by BST to the Local Exchange Company, as described in Section [of this Agreement]

B Sales, use and all other taxes (excluding taxes on BST's meaner) determined by BST or any taxing other ty to be due to any federal, state or local taxing jurisdiction with respect to the provision of the source set forth herein will be paid by the Local Exchange Company. The Local Exchange Company shall have the right to have BST contest with the imposing jurisdiction, at the Local Exchange Company's expense, any with a set for the Local Exchange Company doess are improperly levied.

IV. INDEMNIFICATION

To the extent not prohibited by law, each party will undernnify the other and hold the inher harm/eas against any loss, cost, claim, injury, or hability relating to or ansing out of negligence or willful misconduct by the indernrifying party or its agents or contractors in connection with the indemnifying party's provision of services, provided, however, that any indemnity for any loss, cost, claim, injury or hability arising out of or relating to errors or omissions in the provision of services under this Agreement shall be limited as otherwise specified in this Agreement. The indemnifying party ander this Section agrees to defend any surfaces to notify the other party promptly, in writing, of any written claims, lawsuits, or demands for which the other party is responsible under this Section and to cooperate in every reasonable way to facilitate defense or settlement of claims. The indemnifying party deall not be hable under this Section for settlement by the indemnified party of ally carred, lawsuit in domaid onlyss the defense of the claim, lawsuit, or demand has been tendered to it in writing and the indemnifying party has unreasonably failed to assume such defense.

V. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

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Neither party shall be hable to the other party for any lost profits or revenues or for any induced, mondenizi or convequential cantages incurred by the other party arising from this Agreement or the services performed or not performed hereunder, regardless of the cause of such loss or damage

VI. MISCELLANEOUS

A. It is understood and agreed to by the parties that BST may provide similar services to other computes.

B. All terms, condutions and operations under this Agreement shall be performed in accordance with, and subject to, all applicable local, state or rederal legal and regulatory tamifs, rulings, and other requirements of the federal courts, the U.S. Department of Justice and state and federal regulatory agencies. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to cause either party to violate any such legal or regulatory requirement and either party's obligation to perform shall be subject to all such requirements.

C. The Local Exchange Company agrees to submit to BST all advertising, sales promotion, press releases, and other publicity matters relating to this Agreement wherein BST's corporate or trade names, logos, (rademarks of service marks or those of BST's affiliated companies are menotoned or language from which file connection of said names or trademarks therewith may be inferred or couplied; and the Local Exchange Company further agrees one to publish or use advertising, sales promotions, press releases, or publicity matters without BST's prior written approval.

D This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Local Exchange Company and BST which supersedes all prior agreements or contracts, eral or written representations, statements, regoliations, understandings, proposals and undertakings with respect to the subject matter hereof.

E. Except as expressly provided in this Agreement, if any part of this Agreement is held of construed to be invalid or unenforceable, the validity of any other Section of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect to the extent permissible or appropriate in furtherance of the intent of this Agreement.

F. Neither party shall be held liable for any delay or failure in performance of any puri of this Agreement for any cause beyond its control and without its fault or negligence, such as acts of God, acts of civil or mulitary authonity, government regulations, embargoes, epidemics, war, terrorist sets, roly, insurvenous,

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fries, explosions, earthquakes, nuclear accidents, floods, strikes, power biackeurs, volcanic action, other major environmental disturbances, unusually severe weather conditions, inability to secure products or services of other persons or transportation facilities, or acts or omissions of transportation common carriers.

This Addendum sets forth the terms and conditions for Local Exchange Company's provision of billing number information to BST for inclusion in BST's LIDB - 9ST will store in its LIDB the billing number information provided by Local Exchange Company, and BST will provide responses to on-line, call-by-call queries to rais information for purposes specified in Section LB of the Agreement.

11. DEFINITIONS

A. Bulling number - a number used by BST for the purpose of identifying an account liable for charges. This number may be a line or a special billing number.

B. Line number - a ten digit number assigned by BST that identifies a telephone line associated with a resold local exchange service, or with a SPNP arrangement.

C. Special billing number - a ten digit number that identifies a billing account established by BST.

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in conduction with a caseld local exchange service of with a SPNP arrangement.

D. Calling Card number - 2 billing number plus PIN number assigned by B&F.

F PIN number - a four digit security code assigned by BST which is added to a hilling number to compose a fourteen digit calling card number.

F. Toll billing exception indicator - associated with a billing marber to indicate that it is considered invalid for billing of collect calls or faird number calls or both, by the Local Exchange Company.

G. Billed Number Screening - refers to the activity of determining whether a toll billing exception indicator is present for a particular billing number.

H. Calling Card Validation - refers to the activity of determining whether a particular calling card author exists as stated or otherwise provided by a caller

I. Billing number information - information about billing number or Calling Card number as assigned by BS1 and tell hilling exception instructor provided to BST by the Local Exchange Company.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTIES

A BST will include billing number information associated with resold exchange lines or SPNP amongements in its LIDB. The Local Exchange Company will request any toll billing exceptions will be Local Service Request (LSR) form used to order resold exchange lines, or the SPNP service request form used to order SPNP atrangements.

B. Under normal operating conditions, BST shall bolude the billing number information in its LIDB upon completion of the service order establishing either the resold local exchange service or the SPNP arrangement, provided that BST shall not be held responsible for any delay or failure in performance to the extent such delay or failure is caused by circonnstances or conditions beyond BST's reasonable control. BST will slore in its LIDB an unlimited volume of the working telephone numbers associated with either the resold local exchange lines or the SPNP arrangements. For resold local exchange lines or for SPNP analgements. For resold local exchange lines or for SPNP analgements, BST will issue interbased calling cards only in the name of Local Exchange Company. BST will not use line-based calling cards only in the name of Local Exchange Company. In the event that Local Exchange Company wants to include calling card numbers assigned by the Local Exchange Company in the

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BST 1.1DB, a separate agreement is required.

C. BST will provide responses to on-line, call-by-cull queries to the stored information for the specific purposes listed in the next paragraph.

D BST is authorized to use the billing number information to perform the following functions for authorized assession an on-line basis:

I. Validate a 14 digit Calling Cord number where the first (i) digits are a line number or special billing number assigned by BST, and where the last four digits (PIN) are a security code assigned by BST.

2. Determine whether the Local Exchange Company has identified the billing number as one which should not be billed for collect or third number calls, or both.

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RAO Hosting

- 1. RAO Heating, Calling Card and Third Number Settlement System (CATS) and Non-Intercompany Settlement System (NICS) setvices provided to EZ TATK by BellSouth will be in accordance with the methods and practices regularly adopted and applied by BellSouth to us own operations during the term of this Agreement, including such revisions as may be made from time to finite by BellSouth.
- 2 EZ TALK shall fuorish all relevant information required by BellSouth for the provision of RAO Hosting, CATS and NICS.
- Applicable compensation amounts will be billed by BellSouth to EZ TALK on a monthly basis in angars. Amounts due from one Party to the other fexcluding adjustments) are payable within thirty (70) days of receipt of the billing statement.
- EZ TALK must have its own unique RAO code. Requests for establishment of RAO status where BeilSouth is the selected Centraitzed Message Distribution System (CMDS) interfacing host, require written notification from EZ ?ALKto the BellSouth RAO Hosting coordinator at least eight (8) weeks prior to the proposed effective date. The proposed effective date will be mutually agreed aport between the Parties with consideration given to time necessary for the completion of required Teleordia (formerly BellCore) functions. BellSouth will request, the assignment of an RAO code from its connecting contractor, currently Teleordia (formerly BellCore), on behalf of EZ TALK and will coordinate all issociated conversion activities.
- 5 Belifiouth wall receive messages from EZ TALK that are to be processed by BellSouth, another LEC or CLEC in the BellSouth region or a LEC outside the BellSouth region.
- 6 BeilSouth will perform invoice sequence checking, standard BMI format conting, and balancing of message data with the BMI mailer record counts on all data received from EZ TALK.
- 7 All data received from BZ TALK that is to be processed or billed by another LEC or CLEC within the BellSouth region will be distributed to that LEC or CLEC is accordance with the agreement(s) which may be in effect between BellSouth and the involved LEC or CLEC.
- 8 All data received from EZ_TALK that is to be placed on the CMDS network for distribution ourside the BellSouth region will be handled in accordance with the agreement(s) which may be in effect between BellSouth and its connecting contractor (contently Teleordia (formerly BellCore)).
- 9 BellSouth will receive messages from the CMDS network that are destined to be processed by EZ TALK, and will forward there to FZ TALK on a daily basis.
- 10 Transmission of message data between BellSouth and EZ TALK will be via CONNECT:Direct.
- 11 All messages and related data exchanged herweep BellSouth and EZ TALK will be formatted in accordance with accepted andustry standards for EMI formatted records and packed between appropriate EMI header and mailer records, also in accordance with accepted industry standards.
- EZ TALK will ensure that the recorded message detail necessary to recreate files provided to BellSouth will be maintained for back-up putposes for a period of three (3) calendar months beyond the related message dates
- 15 Should it becette necessary for bZ TALK to send data to BellSouth more than sixty (60) days past the message date(s). EZ TALK will notify BellSouth in advance of the massesission of the data. If there will

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be implicis database the BellSouth region. BellSouth with work with its connecting contractor and EZ TATK to notify all affected Parties.

- 14 In the event that data to be exchanged between the two Parties should become lost or destroyed, both Parties will work together to determine the source of the problem. Once the cause of the problem has been jointly determined and the responsible Party (BeilSouth or EZ TALK) identified and agreed to the company responsible for creating the data (BellSouth or EZ TALK) will make every effort to have the affected data restored and retransmitted. If the data cannot be retrieved, the responsible Party will be liable to the other Party for any resulting bist revenue. I ost revenue may be a combination of revenues that could not be hilled to the end users and associated access revetues. Both Parties will work mgether to estimate the revenue amount based upon historizai data through a method motually agreed upon. The resulting estimated revenue loss will be paid by the responsible Party to the other Party widen three (1) calendar months of the date of problem resolution, or as mutually agreed upon by the Parties.
- 15 Should an error be detected by the EMI format edits performed by BellSouth on data received from EZ TALK, the entire pack containing the affected data will not be processed by BellSouth. BellSouth will notify EZ TALK of the error condition. EZ TALK will correct the error(s) and will resend the entire pack to BellSouth for processing. - 18.1 Rates for message distribution service provided by BellSouth for EZ TALK are as set for in Exhibit A to this Attachment.
- (8.2 Roles for data transmission associated with message distribution service are as set forth in Exhibit A to this Attachment
- 18.3 Data circuits (private line or dial-up) will be required between BellSouth and EZ TALK for the purpose of data transmission. Where a dedicated line is required, EZ TALK will be responsible for ordering the curcait, overseeing its installation and coordinating the installation with BellSouth. EZ TALK will also be responsible for any charges associated with this line. Equipment required on the BellSouth end to altach the hor to the mainframe computer and to transmit successfully ongoing will be negotiated on a case by case basis. 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- 19.1 This Section addresses the settlement of revenues associated with traffic originated from or billed by EZ TALK as a facilities based provider of local exchange relevantations services outside the BellSouth region. Only traffic that originates in one Bell operating territory and bills in another Bell operating territory is included. - 19.3 Grow 62.1 ALK is operating within the BellSouth territory, revenues associated with owlis originated and huled within the BellSouth region will be souled via Teleoretia (formerly BellCore)'s, its successor or assign, NICS system.
- 19.4 BellSouth will receive the monthly NICS reports from Teleordia (formerly BellCore), its successor or assign, on behalf of EZ TALK. BellSouth will distribute copies of these reports to EZ TALK on a monthly parts.
- 19.5 BellSouth will receive the monthly Calling Card and Thard Number Settlement System (CATS) reports from Teleordia (formercy BellCore), its successor of assign, on behalf of EZ TALK. RefSouth will distribute copies of these reports to £Z TALK on a monthly basis.
- 19.6 BellSouth will collect the revenue earned by EZ TALK from the Bell operating company in whose territory the messages are billed (CATS), less a per message tilling and collection fee of five cents (30.05), on behalf of EZ TALK. BellSouth will remit the revenue billed by EZ TALK to the Bell operating company in whose territory the messages originated, less a per message billing and collection fee of five cents (S0.05), on behalf on EZ TALK. These two amounts will be netted together by BellSouth and the resulting charge or credit issued to EZ TALK via a monthly Carner Access Billing System (CABS) miscellaneous bill
- 19.7 BellSouth will collect the revenue carned by EZ TALK within the BellSouth territory from another CLEC also within the BellSouth territory (NICS) where the messages are billed, less a per message billing and collection fee of five cents (\$0.05), on behalf of EZ TALK. BellSouth will remit the revenue billed by EZ TALK within the BellSouth region to the CLEC also within the BellSouth region, where the messages are originated, less a per message billing and collection fee of five cents (\$0.05). These two amounts will be netted together by BellSouth and the resulting charge or credit issued to EZ TALK via a monthly Carrier Access Billing System (CABS) miscellaneous bill.

BellStuth and EZ TALK agree that monthly neared amounts of less than 50y dollars (\$50.00) will not be seriled.

Charges for delivery of the Optional Daily Usage File will appear on the EZ TAUKs' monthly bills. The charges are as set forth in Exlabit A to this Attachment.

- 4 The Optional Daily Usage Feed will contain both rated and unrated messages. All messages will be in the standard Alluance for Telecommunications Industry Solutions (ATIS) EMI record format.

If, however, the EZ TALK should encounter significant volumes of errored messages that prevent processing by the EZ TALK within its systems, BellSouth will work with the EZ TALK to determine the source of the errors and the appropriate resolution.

CALLING NAME DELIVERY (CNAM) DATABASE SERVICES

1.00 DEFINITIONS

For the purpose of this Ahadhment, the following terms shall be defined as:

CALLING NAME DELIVERY DATABASE SERVICE (CNAM) - The ability to associate a name with the railing party number, allowing the end user subscriber (to which a call is being terminated) to view the calling party 5 name before the call is enswered. This service also provides EZ TALKEZ TALK the opportunity to load and store its subscriber names in the BellSouth CNAM SCPs.

CALLING PARTY NUMBER (CPN) - The number of the colling party that is delivered to the terminating so toke using common channel signalog system 7 (CCS7) technology, and that is contained in the initial Address Message (IAW) person of the CCS7 call setup.

COMMON CHANNEL SIGNALING SYSTEM 7 (CCS7) - A network signaling top of object to which all signaling information between two on more nodes is transmitted over high speed data links, eather than over voice circuits.

SERVICE CONTROL POINTS (SCPs) - The real-time data base systems flut contain the names to be provided in response to queries received from CNAM SSPs.

SERVICE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (SMS) - The main operations support system of CNAM DATABASE SERVICE. CNAM records are loaded into the SMS, which in turn downloads into the CNAM SCP.

SERVICE SWITCHING POINTS (SSPs) - Features of computerized switches in the telephone network that illutermine that a terminating line has subscribed to CNAM services, and then communicate with CNAM SCPs in most to provide the name associated with the calling party number.

SUBSYSTEM NUMBER (SSN) - The address used in the Signaling Connection Control Part (SCCP) layer of the SS7 protocol to designate an application at an end signaling point. A SSN for CNAM as the end office designates the CNAM application within the end office. BellSouth uses the CNAM SSN of 232.

A FLACHMENT.

- 2.01 This Attachment contains the terms and conditions where BellSouth will provide to the EZ TALK access to the BellSouth CNAM SCP for query of record storage purposes.
- 2.03 EZ TALK shall submit to BellSouth a notice of its intent to access and utilize BellSouth CNAM Database Services pursuant to the terms and conditions of this Attachment. Said notice shall be in writing, no less than 60 days pror to EZ TALK's access to BellSouth's CNAM Database Services and shall be addressed to BZ TALK's Account Manager.
- 3.00 PILYSICAL CONNECTION AND COMPENSATION
- 3.01 BellSouth's provision of CNAM Database Services to EZ TALK requires interconnection from EZ TALK. EZ TALKIO BellSouth CNAM Service Control Points (SCPs). Such interconnections shall be established pursuant to Attackment 3 of this Agreement. The appropriate charge for access to and use of the BellSouth CNAM Database service shall be as set forth in this Attachment.
- 3.02 In order to formulate a CNAM query to be sent to the BellSouth CNAM SCP, E7 TATK EZ TALKshall provide its own CNAM SSP. EZ TALK'S EZ TALKONAM SSPs must be compliant with TR-NWT-001188, "CLASS Calling Name Delivery Generic Requirements".

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- 3.03 If E7 TALK elects to access the BellSouth CNAM SCP via a third party CCS7 transport provider, the fluid party CCS7 provider shall interconnect with the BellSouth CCS7 network according to BellSouth's Common Channel Signaling Interconnection Guidelines and Telcordia (formerly BellCore)'s CCS Network Interface Specification document, TR-TSV-000905. In addition, the fluid party provider shall establish CCS7 interconnection at the BellSouth Local Signal Transfer Points (LSTPs) serving the BellSouth CNAM SCPs that EZ TALK desires to query.
- 3.04 <u>Out-Of-Region Customers.</u> If the customer queries the BellSouth CNAM SCP via a third party national SS7 transport provider, the third party SS7 provider shall interconnect with the BellSouth CCS7 network according to BellSouth's Common Channel Signaling Interconnection Guidelines and BellSouth's CCS Network Interface Specification document, TR-TSV-000905 in addition, the third party provider shell visibilish SS7 interconnection at one or more of the BellSouth Gateway Signal Transfer Points (STPs). The payment of all costs associated with the transport of SS7 signals via a third party will be established by memal agreement of the parties and writing shall, by this reference become an integral part of this Agreement.

4.00 CNAM RECORD INITIAL LOAD AND UPDATES.

- 4.01 The mechanism to be used by EZ TALK for initial CNAM record load and/or opdates shall be determined by mitual agreement. The initial load and all updates shall be provided by EZ TALK in the BellSouth specified formal and shall contain records for every working telephone number that can originate phone calls. It is the responsibility of EZ TALK to provide accurate information to BellSouth on a current basis.
- 4.02 Updates to the SMS shall occur no less than once a week, reflect service order activity affecting either name or telephone number, and involve only record additions, deletions or changes.
- 4.03 EZ TALX CNAM records provided for storage in the BellSouth CNAM SCP shall be available, on a SCP query basis only, to all parties querying the BellSouth CNAM SCP. Further, CNAM service shall be provided by each party consistent with state and/or federal regulation.
