Issue 1: Should the utility's request to apply its service availability
charges uniformly in Marion County be approved?

Recommendation: Yes. The utility's proposed Sixth Revised Tariff Sheet No. 28.0 should be approved. <u>Issue 2</u>: Should this docket be closed?

<u>Recommendation</u>: Yes. If Issue 1 is approved, the tariff sheets should be effective in accordance with Rule 25.30-475, Florida Administrative Code. If a protest is filed by a substantially affected person within 21 days of the issuance of the Order, this tariff should remain in effect with any increase held subject to refund pending resolution of the protest. If no timely protest is filed, this docket should be closed upon the issuance of a consummating order.
