2	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Call the prehearing
3	conference to order. Could I have the notice read,
4	please.
5	MS. CALDWELL: Notice has been given of this
6	prehearing conference in docket number for a prehearing
7	conference for this time and date in Docket Number
8	990884-TP, request by Orlando Telephone Company for
9	approval of arbitration concerning complaint against
10	Sprint Florida, Incorporated regarding enforcement of
11	interconnection agreement.
12	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Appearances.
13	MR. REHWINKEL: Good morning, Commissioner.
14	Charles J. Rehwinkel on behalf of Sprint Florida,
15	Incorporated.
16	MR. ERWIN: I'm David B. Erwin on behalf of
17	Orlando Telephone Company.
18	MS. CALDWELL: Diana Caldwell on behalf of the
19	staff of the Florida Public Service Commission.
20	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Ms. Caldwell, are there
21	any preliminary matters?
22	MS. CALDWELL: No, sir, there are not.
23	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Do the parties have any
24	preliminary matters?
25	MR. REHWINKEL: No, sir.
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1	MR. ERWIN: No, sir.
2	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. My intention
3	is to proceed through the draft prehearing order, which I
4	believe we can do in short order. We will begin with
5	Section 1, conduct of proceedings; Section 2, case
6	background; Section 3, confident information; Section 4,
7	post-hearing procedures; Section 5, testimony and
8	exhibits; Section 6, order of witnesses.
9	Is there any change to the order?
10	MS. CALDWELL: Yes, Commissioner. We have
11	talked about this earlier. And Joan Seymour, instead of
12	being all, Issue Number 2 is a legal issue, so Joan
13	Seymour would be testifying to Issues 1, 3(A), 3(B), 4 and
14	5.
15	COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. Section 7,
16	basic positions. Any changes or corrections? Section 8,
17	issues and positions.
18	We will begin with Issue 1, changes or
19	corrections. Let me ask a question about Issue 1. I
20	noticed that under Sprint's position it is that we should
21	not be hearing this case at this time. Obviously this
22	case is set for hearing, and we are going to proceed
23	unless there is some settlement or something in the
24	meantime. I guess the question is for Sprint. I
25	understand this is your position.

5 1 Are you objecting to these hearings? MR. REHWINKEL: Commissioner Deason, it may be 2 3 that we argue in our brief that one of the options the Commission has is to make no decision because this case is 4 5 premature. 6 COMMISSIONER DEASON: So you will pursue that in 7 your brief and our staff will address that in the final recommendation. 8 9 MR. REHWINKEL: Yes. 10 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. Issue 2; Issue 3(A); 3(B); Issue 4; Issue 5. I read that the 11 parties do agree as to the number of minutes in question 12 and the dollars associated with those minutes, is that 13 correct? 14 MR. REHWINKEL: That's correct, although we do 15 have a slight change to the language in the stipulation 16 17 section. COMMISSIONER DEASON: Okay. We will get to that 18 then. But there is no change to Issue 5? Okay. 19 Section 9, exhibit list. Section 10, proposed 20 stipulations. 21 MS. CALDWELL: In Section 10, the fourth line, 22 after "paid OTC by Sprint," delete "for interstate 23 terminating access," so that sentence or the last portion 24 25 of that sentence would read, "and the amount paid OTC by

Sprint is \$59,814.74." 1 2 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. 3 MR. ERWIN: I thought we might say the amount paid OTC by Sprint to date, or something. 4 5 MR. REHWINKEL: That's fine. 6 MS. CALDWELL: Okay. 7 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Show that change also, 8 then. 9 MR. REHWINKEL: Mr. Erwin, would it be appropriate, since there were other amounts paid, to put 10 the word relevant in front of amount? 11 MR. ERWIN: Huh. There was some intrastate 12 payments made. But since you don't want to say 13 interstate, then --14 MR. REHWINKEL: Well, we could say the relevant 15 16 interstate amount paid. MR. ERWIN: Yes, that would be fine. 17 18 MR. REHWINKEL: Okay. COMMISSIONER DEASON: Does staff have any 19 objection? 20 MS. CALDWELL: No, we don't. 21 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Show then that change also 22 23 made. Section 11, pending motions. To my understanding 24 there are no pending motions? 25 MR. REHWINKEL: Correct.

1 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Section 12. There are no requests for confidential treatment. And there are no 2 3 rulings that have been made or need to be made at this 4 point, is that correct? 5 MR. ERWIN: Correct. MR. REHWINKEL: That's correct. 6 7 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. Are there any final matters which need to be brought before the 8 9 prehearing officer at this time? 10 MS. CALDWELL: None that I am aware of. 11 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Do the parties have 12 anything? 13 MR. REHWINKEL: No. 14 COMMISSIONER DEASON: Very well. 15 Thank you all for your participation and cooperation; and this prehearing conference is adjourned. 16 17 MR. REHWINKEL: Thank you.
