**APPLICATION FOR APPROVAL OF TARIFF SHEETS
FOR WHOLESALE WATER AND WASTEWATER SERVICE**

United Water Florida Inc., a Florida corporation ("United Water Florida"), by and through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this Application for Approval of Tariff Sheets for Wholesale Water and Wastewater Service (hereinafter referred to as the "Application") pursuant to Section 367.091 of the Florida Statutes (1999), and Rule 25-9.005(4) of the Florida Administrative Code ("FAC"), and states:

1. United Water Florida is a water and wastewater utility company doing business in Duval, Nassau, and St. Johns Counties, Florida, pursuant to Certificates of Authorization numbered 236-W and 179-S ("Certificates") issued by the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission").
2. The exact name of United Water Florida and the address of its principal place of business are United Water Florida Inc., 1400 Millcoe Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32225.
3. United Water Florida was incorporated under the laws of the State of Florida on June 5, 1937. United Waterworks Inc. owns one hundred percent (100%) of the capital stock of United

Water Florida. United Waterworks Inc.'s address is 200 Old Hook Road, Harrington Park, New Jersey 07640-1799.

5. St. Joe Utilities Company ("St. Joe") is a Florida corporation authorized to provide water and wastewater service in St. Johns County, Florida. St. Joe is regulated by the St. Johns County Water and Sewer Authority ("Authority") and the Board of County Commissioners of St. Johns County ("Board").
6. St. Joe has requested United Water Florida to provide St. Joe with wholesale water and wastewater service to enable St. Joe to provide retail water and wastewater service in the service area authorized for St. Joe by the Authority and the Board ("St. Joe Service Area"). Copies of a legal description and map of the St. Joe Service Area provided to United Water Florida by St. Joe are attached hereto as Exhibits A and B.
7. The provision of wholesale water and wastewater service to St. Joe by United Water Florida will be a new class of service for United Water Florida.
8. St. Joe and United Water Florida have entered into a Wholesale Water and Wastewater Purchase Agreement ("Agreement"). The Agreement provides that St. Joe is to pay the contributions to

utility plant, Allowance for Funds Prudently Invested ("AFPI") charges, and meter installation fees in United Water Florida's Tariff approved by the Commission. St. Joe is also to pay for service at United Water Florida's wholesale water and wastewater service rates which have not yet been established. The proposed wholesale water and wastewater service rates for service to the St. Joe Service Area by United Water Florida are set forth on Exhibits C and D, which are proposed tariff sheets.

9. In the Agreement, St. Joe has agreed that it will pay to United Water Florida all contributions, fees, amounts and other charges in accordance with, and be bound by all other provisions of, the Tariff approved for United Water Florida by the Commission or other governmental or regulatory authority as being applicable at the time that connections are made, services are provided or other actions are taken by United Water Florida. St. Joe further agreed that it will comply with all rules, regulations and operating procedures of United Water Florida approved for United Water Florida by the Commission or other governmental or regulatory authority as being applicable at the time that actions are to be taken by St. Joe or United Water Florida.
10. The purpose and reason for the new service classification is to enable United Water Florida to provide wholesale water and wastewater service to St. Joe.

11. Buildout of the St. Joe Service Area is expected to take several years. According to St. Joe, the proposed Bartram Trail High School, which is scheduled to open in 2000, is the first customer in the St. Joe Service Area anticipated to be served by St. Joe. The high school is expected to require 28 equivalent residential connections ("ERCs"). St. Joe currently does not project any additional customers in its service area until 2002. St. Joe projects that it will eventually have 6,000 water ERCs and wastewater ERCs in its service area.

12. The estimated annual revenues to be derived for the first two years of the Agreement are as follows:

a. For 2000

(i) Water

28 ERCs x 350 gallons per day ("GPD") x 365
days x 182.5 days (½ year) ÷ 1000
365.0 days
gallons x \$1.09 = \$1,949.47

(ii) Wastewater

28 ERCs x 280 GPD x 365 days
x 182.5 days ÷ 1000 gallons x
365.0 days
\$3.06 = \$4,378.25

(iii) Total - \$1,949.47 + \$4,378.25 = \$6,327.72

b. For 2001

(i) Water

28 ERCs x 350 GPD x 365 days ÷ 1000 x
\$1.09 = \$3,898.93

(ii) Wastewater

28 ERCs x 280 GPD x 365 days ÷ 1000 x
\$3.06 = \$8,756.50

(iii) Total - \$3,898.93 + \$8,756.50 = \$12,655.43

WHEREFORE, United Water Florida respectfully requests the Commission do the following: (i) approve the wholesale water and wastewater service rates for the St. Joe Service Area requested in this Application; and (ii) approve the tariff sheets attached as Exhibits C and D.

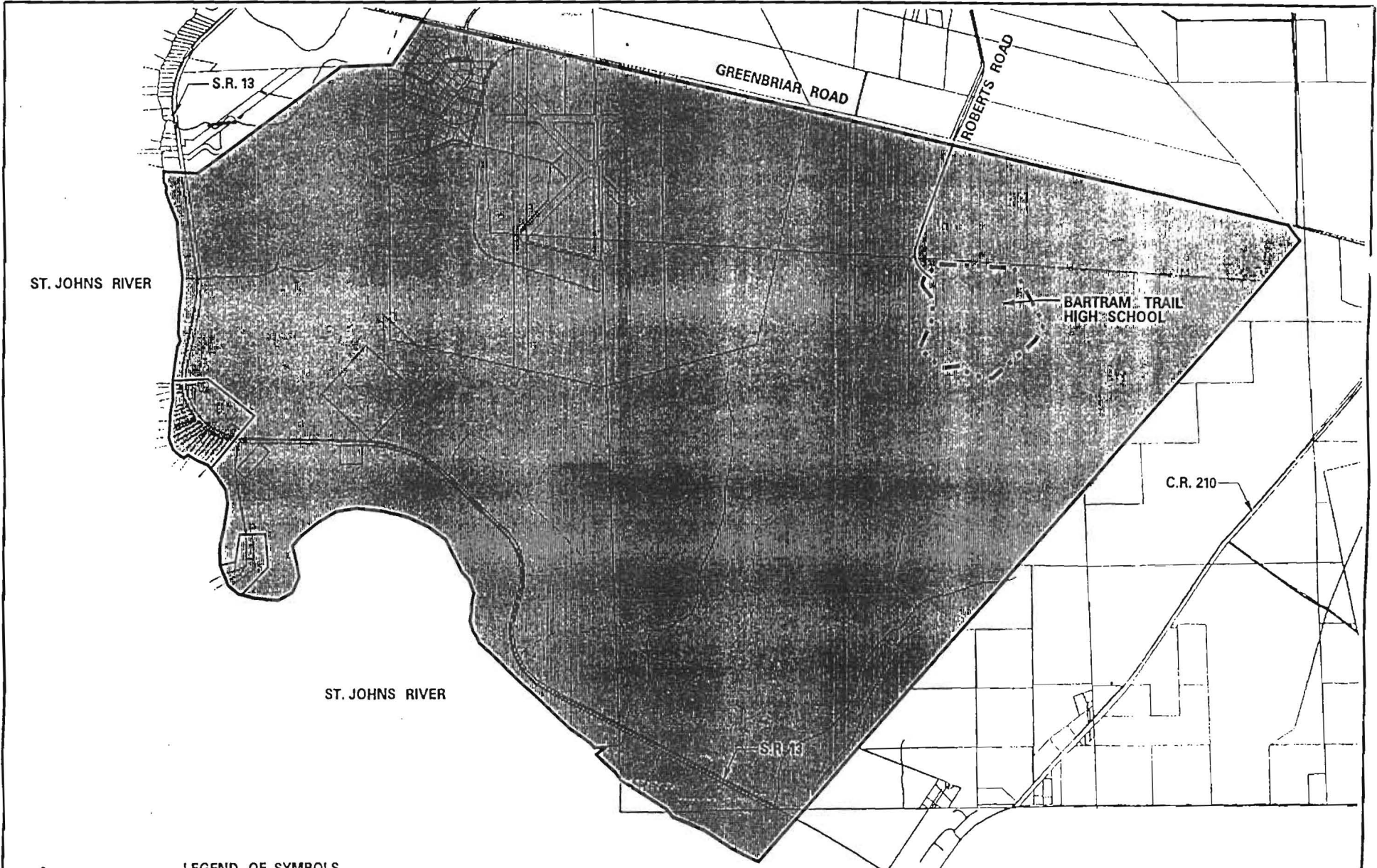

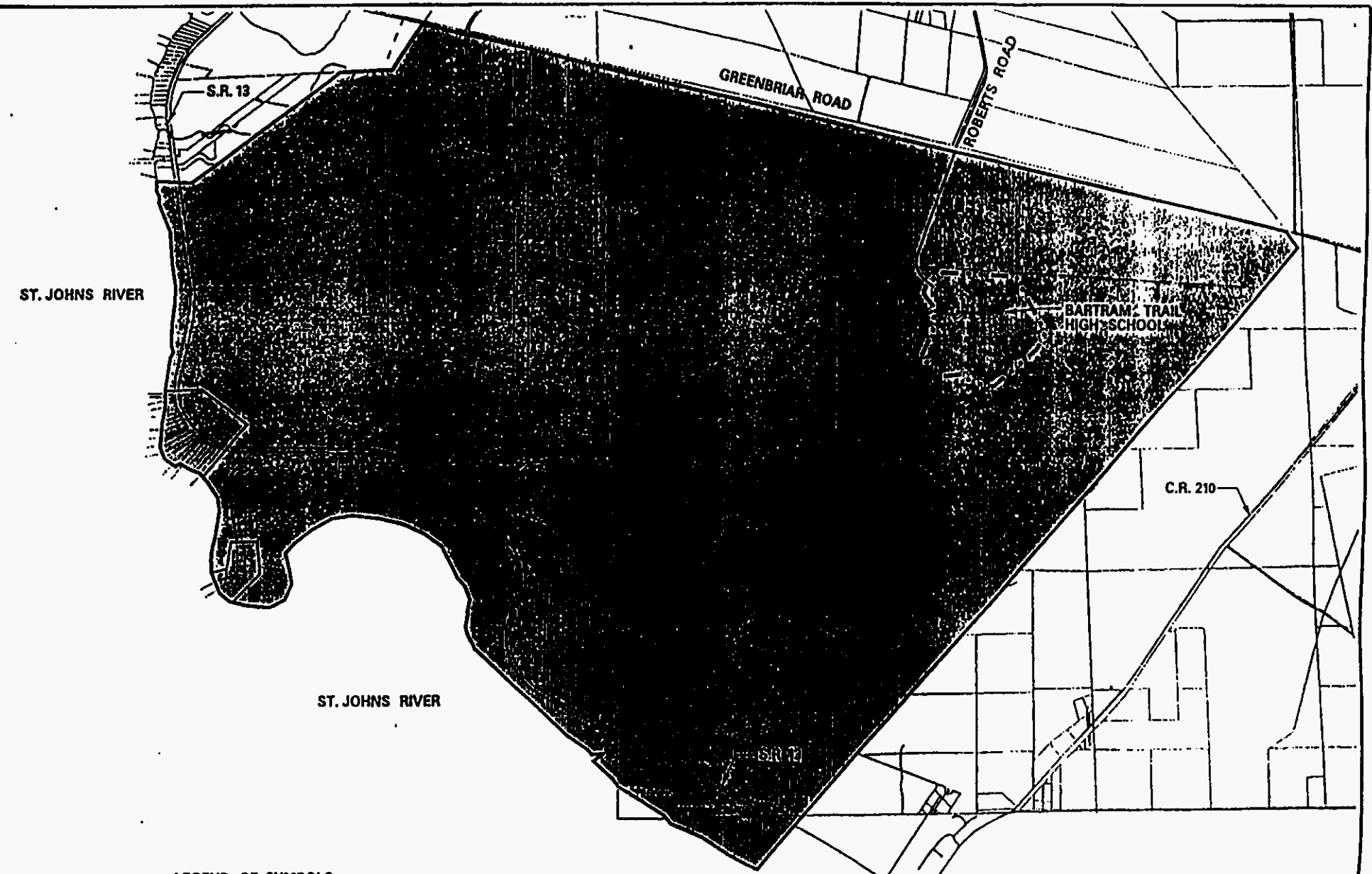

TERMS OF PAYMENT:

After five (5) working days written notice is mailed to the customer separate and apart from any other bill, service may be discontinued. Bills will be rendered in arrears for consumption charges (quantity rates) monthly or for other periods if notice is given to the Customer.

BILLING ADJUSTMENTS:
