(KMCII) (collectively, KMC) filed a Petition with this Commission alleging breach of the Interconnection Agreement and requesting expedited relief. BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. (BST) is certificated in Florida as a local exchange company. and KMCII are certified in Florida as alternative local exchange companies. On February 24, 1997, KMCI and BST entered into an agreement for BST to provide interconnection services to KMCI. February 23, 1998, KMCII opted into the same agreement with BST. On August 30, 1999, pursuant to the requirements of the Agreement, KMC notified BST by letter of several complaints alleging that BST had breached the Interconnection Agreement. The parties had been unable to resolve the complaints. Pursuant to Order No. PSC-00-0310-PCO-TP, this matter has been scheduled for administrative hearing on May 12, 2000.
