We have received your payments for the 1998 and 1999 regulatory assessment fees. However, if you wish to keep your IXC certificate active, you also need to make a settlement offer. In other cases dealing with this rule violation, the Commission has accepted a \$100 settlement in lieu of the \$500 fine imposed. The settlement letter needs to include the following:

- Docket number;
- Statement that it has taken steps to prevent future late payments of the regulatory assessment fees; and
- Make a specific monetary settlement.

Any settlement offer should be addressed to Ms. Blanca Bayó, Director, Division of Records and Reporting, Florida Public Service Commission, at the above address. The proposed settlement amount should <u>not</u> be paid at this time. It will become due after the Commissioners vote on this issue.
