

## PROCEEDINGS

COMMISSIONER CLARK: We'll call the prehearing to order. Would you read the Notice?

MR. JAEGER: Okay. Pursuant to amended Notice issued March 7th this year, this time and place has been set for a second prehearing conference in docket number 960545-WS, investigation of utility rates and quality of service of the Seven Springs division of Aloha utilities Inc. in Pasco County.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Take appearances.
Mr. Deterding.

MR. DETERDING: F. Marshall Deterding here on behalf of Aloha utilities.

MR. MCLEAN: Harold McLean, 111 West Madison

Street, Tallahassee, Florida, appearing on behalf of the

citizens of the state of Florida and insofar as prehearing

conference is concerned, the interest of Mr. Mike Fasano,

who is an intervenor.

MR. JAEGER: I'm Ralph Jaeger, and with me is Jason Fudge on behalf of Commission staff, 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-0850.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay, Mr. Jaeger, what do we need to do? I didn't see anything in the prehearing order that indicated that there was a lot we had to do today.

MR. JAEGER: There are two pending matters, actually. And both of them involved DEP witnesses.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay.

MR. JAEGER: Michael D. LeRoy initially asked that he just be allowed to testify on the afternoon of the 29th, but he's now become available on both days. So, he's withdrawn that request. So, that part of the prehearing is on page 15, I think, pending matters -- or 14, I'm sorry. So, the first sentence, he's withdrawn that request. And I think we can just cross through that.

And then staff witness, Peter Screnock, he has a conflict on the 29th. And he requests that he be allowed to just come on the 30th and testify on the morning of 30th. And I think all the parties agreed that that would be acceptable.

COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. We'll show that in the listing of witnesses that indicate that next to that witness that he will testify the morning of the 30th.

MR. JAEGER: Okay.

MR. MCLEAN: Commissioner, I might be odd man out on this deal, but -- pardon me.

For those two witnesses, I'm not going to have any questions for them that would require their appearance. If they come, I'll probably have a question or two, but they don't need to show up for me.

1 MR. DETERDING: I am. 2 MR. JAEGER: Do you need both of them, Marty, 3 Peter Screnock, too? 4 MR. DETERDING: Yeah. You know, their 5 testimony, to some degree --6 COMMISSIONER CLARK: That's fine, Mr. Deterding. 7 If you need them there, they'll be there. MR. DETERDING: Just wanted to explain. 8 9 MR. JAEGER: We discussed Michael LeRoy, but we 10 hadn't discussed Peter Screnock. 11 I'd like to thank the parties for agreeing to 12 allow Commissioner Jaber to participate as a hearing 13 officer in this proceeding. 14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: As would I. 15 Is there anything -- have you read over the 16 prehearing order, and is there anything that needs to be 17 changed? MR. MCLEAN: I think there's a bit of confusion. 18 19 Let me see if I can -- page 14 of the facts of the 20 prehearing order -- let me see if I can. There's 21 reference there to a exhibit, SGW-2. I didn't bring 22 Mr. Watford's testimony, but I believe that -- I don't 23 think there is an SGW-2 rebuttal. I think that should read "SGW-1," but --24 25 MR. JAEGER: Okay. What I --

1 MR. MCLEAN: Mr. Watford had a rebuttal exhibit 2 addressing the expenses. And that was stricken. 3 that's SGW-1R, but for some reason I didn't bring it. MR. JAEGER: Okay. There were two exhibits, and 4 5 you moved to strike just exhibit one, but both exhibits 6 did go to somewhat on expenses. So, I think, you know, I 7 didn't bring Mr. Watford's, but you did not move to strike exhibit 2 and that has not been stricken, but there is no 8 9 issue on rate case expense. And so, I don't know. I think that exhibit does 10 11 go to, you know, the expenses that -- but you did not, for 12 some reason that didn't get stricken, and that was not in 13 your motion. 14 MR. MCLEAN: I don't think I have SGW-2, but I 15 can't say, because I didn't bring the testimony. MR. DETERDING: I don't have it either. 16 17 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Well, it strikes me that we 18 could take it up at the beginning of the hearing. If it needs to be stricken, we'll do it then. 19 20 MR. MCLEAN: Okay. 21 MR. JAEGER: Okay. Nothing further. 22 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Deterding, anything? 23 MR. DETERDING: No. 24 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Mclean, anything? 25 MR. MCLEAN: I'll have no questions for FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION

Mr. Nixon, unless he comes. If he is there, I may have a 1 question or two, but I don't have anything important 2 enough to require his appearance as a witness. 3 MR. JAEGER: Staff doesn't have any cross for 4 Nixon. 5 6 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Then we can 7 stipulate his testimony into the record at the beginning of the hearing and indicate parties have waived 8 9 cross-examination. If you would -- I was going to say alert the 10 presiding officer. I quess I'll know, but remind us to do 11 12 that at the beginning, and Mr. Nixon will be excused from 13 appearing, Mr. Deterding? 14 Now, are there any other witness for whom there might not be cross-examination? Everybody else will be 15 questioned? 16 Okay. 17 MR. DETERDING: There aren't any others. COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Biddy and --18 MR. DETERDING: Porter and Watford. 19 20 COMMISSIONER CLARK: I suppose, if we didn't have to be there -- what time does it start on the first 21 22 day, the 29th? MR. JAEGER: 10:00 is what it's noticed for. 23 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Okay. Well, we'll have to 24 be there the next day anyway to hear from the last 25

witness. MR. JAEGER: We have the customer testimony that 2 night, so we were going to be there the nights of --3 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Good point. All right. 4 Well, is there anything further to come before us at this 5 point? 6 MR. MCLEAN: Well, I've always thought it would 7 be nice to have witness summaries off the record for the 8 reason that if they talk about something that's not in 9 their prefiled testimony and it ain't admissible, and if 10 it's the same as in their prefiled testimony, it's 11 cumulative. So, in either sense, it seems to me like it's 12 pointless to put it on the record. 13 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Well, that certainly is a 14 novel request. I mean, we've always done it that way. I 15 personally think it's sort of -- it is useful in the sense 16 in that it reorients the commissioners to what this 17 particular witness is --18 MR. MCLEAN: I agree. Just my thought it ought 19 to be off the record. 20 COMMISSIONER CLARK: I'm sure the witnesses will 21 keep their summaries confined to their prefiled testimony. 22 With that, this prehearing is adjourned. Thank 23 24 you.
