## REQUEST TO FILE EMERGENCY RECOMMENDATION

By Order No. PSC-00-0377-PAA-TL, issued February 22, 2000, the Commission approved the transfer of control of GTC, Inc. to MJD Ventures, Inc. No protest was filed and the Consummating Order was issued on March 17, 2000. On March 27, 2000, GTC brought to the staff's attention the fact that a clarifying amendment had been filed in the Docket on January 20. 2000, before the Commission's Order Approving the Transfer had been issued. This amendment clarifies that GTC's parent company, TPG is also part of the transfer of stock. Therefore, the company has requested that the Commission clarify that TPG is also part of this transaction. although TPG is not itself certificated in Florida. GTC emphasizes that the closing on the transaction is Friday, March 31, 2000, and that finalization of the transaction is largely dependent upon this clarification. As such, staff requests permission to file a late-filed, emergency recommendation regarding the requested clarification. Staff believes that addressing this matter as soon as possible is necessary in furtherance of the previously approved transaction.
