ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

By Petition, Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. (Time Warner) has requested permission to intervene in this proceeding. Time Warner states that it is an alternate local exchange company providing exchange access and local exchange (ALEC) telecommunications services in the State of Florida, and, as such, is subject to the Commission's rules, regulations and orders. Time Warner states that it must utilize the operations support systems of incumbent local exchange companies (ILEC) in order to provide local exchange service in Florida. Thus, Time Warner states that any decision in this case will directly and substantially affect Time Warner's interests.

Having reviewed the Petition, it appears that Time Warner's substantial interests may be affected by this proceeding. As an ALEC operating in Florida, Time Warner states that it must utilize the operations support systems of ILECs to provide local exchange service. Thus, Time Warner has sufficiently demonstrated that its substantial interests may be affected by the outcome of this proceeding. Pursuant to Rule 25-22.039, Florida Administrative Code, Time Warner takes the case as it finds it.

Therefore, it is

ORDERED by the Florida Public Service Commission that the Petition for Leave to Intervene filed by Time Warner Telecom of Florida, L.P. is hereby granted. It is Further

A motion for reconsideration shall be filed with the Director, Division of Records and Reporting, in the form prescribed by Rule 25-22.060, Florida Administrative Code. Judicial review of a preliminary, procedural or intermediate ruling or order is available if review of the final action will not provide an adequate remedy. Such review may be requested from the appropriate court, as described above, pursuant to Rule 9.100, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure.
