DISCUSSION OF ISSUES

ISSUE 1: Should the Commission suspend Florida Power & Light Company's petition to revise its Curtailable Service tariff?

RECOMMENDATION: Yes. The Commission should suspend Florida Power & Light Company's petition to revise its Curtailable Service tariff. [WHEELER]

STAFF ANALYSIS: Pursuant to Section 366.06(3), Florida Statutes, the Commission may withhold consent to the operation of all or any portion of a new rate schedule, delivering to the utility requesting such increase, within 60 days, a reason or written statement of good cause for doing so. Staff recommends that the proposed tariff be suspended to allow staff the opportunity to request more supporting data, and additional time to evaluate the

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petition. Staff believes this is good cause, consistent with the requirement of Section 366.06(3), Florida Statutes.

ISSUE 2: Should this docket be closed?
