**BY ORDER OF THE COURT:**

Having considered appellant Sugarmill Woods Civic Association's motion to supplement the record, as well as appellees' motions opposing supplementation, the motion is hereby granted. The court deems the request of appellee Florida Water Services for this court to take judicial notice of the underlying evidentiary record in Sugarmill Woods v. Southern States Utilities, Inc., 687 So. 2d 1346 (Fla. 1st DCA 1997), contained within its response to the motion filed by Sugarmill Woods, to be a motion for this court to take judicial notice of that record. The motion is hereby granted and the clerk of the Florida Public Service Commission is directed to return the record in this court's case numbers 95-425 and 95-457 to this court within 30 days from the date of this order.
