On March 27, 2000, Florida Power & Light Company, Fand Florida Power Corporation each filed separate Petations total Intervene in these two dockets. The cases have since cheer consolidated for hearing. Panda Leesburg Power Partners, L.P. and Panda Midway Power Partners, L.P. (collectively referred to as Panda) have filed timely responses in opposition to the petitions. Panda has also asked for Oral Argument on the issue. Prehearing Officer has referred the decision on the intervention requests to the full Commission.

The hearing in these dockets is scheduled for July 12-14, The next regularly scheduled agenda is May 16, 2000. potential intervenors also filed several other motions which could alter the timing of events, including the hearing. In addition, the potential intervenors have no right to conduct discovery until they are granted party status. Waiting until the next regularly scheduled agenda conference to present the Intervention to the Commissioners could have the effect of delaying the hearing. Procedurally, it is most efficient to rule on the Motions to Intervene as soon as possible so that the scheduling issues can be resolved in a timely manner. For these reasons, staff requests permission to file its recommendation on the Petitions to Intervene on April 17, 2000, at 12:00 noon, for the Agenda Conference on April 18, 2000.
